Hi everyone. We'd like to thank all those people who came to our Egg Hunt and Indoor Fayre and to all our stall holders. It was a great morning with over 80 children doing the egg hunt. We'll be making a donation to Cancer Research in memory of Linda McKay, the Child Development Officer from Central Bedfordshire Council who was a fantastic support to us when we started Clophill Preschool in 2013. We'll be putting the rest towards our outdoor water equipment and the new allotment.

At the end of last term we had our Easter Craft session and lots of parents/grandparents joined us in making all sorts of fun and upcycled crafts including egg prints in shaving foam and paint. Also joining in with the craftmaking was Rosemary from St. Mary's Church, who came to talk about Easter and show her palm crosses to the children. Vicar Graham from the Methodist Church also came up before Easter and read the children the Easter Story, complete with Makaton signs.





We're also focusing on food. Lynne is making her healthy **recipes** with the children as usual. and we hope to supplement our cookery and snack times with food grown by the children on our new allotment. We're very lucky to have so many supportive parents and grandparents who've offered to help us with planting and maintenance. A huge thank you goes to our families for helping to get **the allotment** ready – log posts, rabbit wire fences and a gate have been put up so that we can work in there safely and we're making wood chip paths and log edging. We hope to include a willow den and a wood stump seating area for storytelling.

This term sees Chris starting her new role as PANCo (Physical Activity and Nutrition Coordinator) which is a very important role now within preschools to encourage and help support healthy lifestyles for children and their families. It means we're developing our physical play even further, with **a new Scooter Day each week** as well as ensuring we have gross motor physical play inside at all times. Mini Moves is still coming in each week to do dance, movement and music linked to the Early Years Curriculum and we're also asking any parents to come in and do activities such as **ring game and songs, football and racquet games**. We have one dad coming in to do boot camp with the children!

We're exploring the world and other countries at preschool and have our new **World Around Us board** which shows the different countries some our children have lived in, visited or come from. The role play is set up as a travel agent and children have been packing their suitcases to go on holiday and building ships and planes outside ready to go on their travels. We've been exploring other languages using our dual language books and learning how people from different countries say hello.

So it's 'Adios' from us until we say 'Ni hao' in June!

We're all very excited in Nursery about the new building and the children are looking at resource catalogues with the staff to decide what they'd like in their new space. We know there are only a few children in the nursery now who will be transferring to the new nursery but we feel it's important to get children's opinion and keep up to date with their current interests.

We've started transition with the children leaving in September to join Chestnut. Each child will have a chance to spend at least three sessions in Chestnut class before the official transfer day in July. This has worked really well in past years and the children settle very quickly if they've had this opportunity. News from Rotary Club of Barton

At its AGM last month the Club reviewed its activities and achievements during the past Rotary year. The reports from the committee chairman highlighted the extensive support the Club had given to those far less fortunate than us, particularly in less developed countries. These include...

Entrepreneurs in developing countries

Following an initial donation of £1,500 from both the Club and individual members the money is distributed as small microloans, usually less than £100, to aspiring entrepreneurs in developing countries. The activities supported include farming, cafes, sewing and retail shops. As the loan is repaid the money is then used to support other applicants. To date over 1,000 entrepreneurs and their families in countries including Zambia,

Vietnam, Ecuador, Philippines, Rwanda, Malawi, Zimbabwe and Cambodia have been helped, with 645 jobs supported.

Schools in South Africa

Working with the Rotary Club of Grahamstown, Barton helped to raise £8,500 to support work with five schools in Eastern Cape which is one of the poorest provinces in South Africa. The project involved two primaries, a secondary school, a school for those with special needs and one for street children. It provided support for rainwater harvesting systems for producing vegetables from small irrigated gardens as well as incomegenerating activities like the making of educational toys. Some 500 people participated in the activities including nursery school and high school children, teachers and parents.

Children affected by HIV and AIDS

This project in Swaziland required the Club to raise £850 to help supply electricity to a school where children from HIV- and AIDS-affected families and communities are being educated. Educational material donated by Orchard School in Barton has also been dispatched to the school.

Tools for use in Africa

Once again this year the Club actively supported Tools for Self Reliance in Milton Keynes, where adults with learning difficulties refurbish tools for use in a number of African countries. The Club provided funding to update and re-equip the workshop to enable it to function more effectively in the refurbishment of the tools.

Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Lemon Polenta Cake



INGREDIENTS Serves 4

For the cake ...

- 3 large free range eggs
- 110g caster sugar
- 50g ground almonds
- 2 lemons zest and juice
- 100g polenta
- 1tsp baking powder
- 2 tbsp olive oil

1. Pre-heat the oven to 180°.

- 2. Separate the eggs. Put the yolks in a bowl with the caster sugar and beat at a high speed until they're pale, thick and creamy.
- **3.** Continue to beat, pouring in the lemon juice a little at a time until the mixture starts to thicken.
- Add the lemon zest, polenta, baking powder, ground almonds and olive oil and beat until it looks like a paste.

For the syrup...

- 100g caster sugar
- 100ml water
- 3 sprigs of rosemary
- juice of 1 lemon

To decorate...

- 1 lemon sliced thinly
- 2 sprigs of rosemary



- 5. Beat the egg whites until almost stiff then fold into the cake mixture.
- **6.** Pour the mixture into a greased 10in cake tin and bake for 35 mins until the centre is thoroughly cooked and the top slightly browned.
- **7.** Whilst the cake is baking prepare the syrup by combining the ingredients and heating until it just come to the boil and the sugar is dissolved.
- **8.** Strain the syrup to remove the rosemary sprigs and keep warm until the cake comes out of the oven.
- **9.** Remove the cake from the tin and place on a cooling rack. Prick the surface all over with a toothpick and spoon over the warm syrup.
- **10.** Once the cake is cool place on a serving plate and decorate with the thin slices of lemon and sprigs of rosemary.

This cake is perfect for someone who's avoiding gluten as polenta is a maize flour.

Clophill & District Flower Club

Snatching triumph from disaster at our 6th April meeting was Lesley Sturdy, a stalwart of our club and of NAFAS, who stepped in at very short notice when our advertised demonstrator was taken ill. Lesley has trained and judged demonstrators for many years and is much respected for her





expertise and advice on matters floral.

We were privileged to enjoy a preview of a programme that Lesley had prepared for another event. Entitled 'The Changing Year', it took us on a whistle-stop tour through the seasons, from midsummer through autumn, winter, early spring and back to the approaching summer.

Lesley's designs beautifully illustrated the drama and colour of the seasons. Hot orange gerberas, bright lilies and cymbidium orchids gave us a tropical summer, followed by gentle bronze and rust gold chrysanthemums of autumn. We then had snowy white and cream 'Avalanche' roses, white carnations and a sprinkling of gypsophila for a wintery effect. Spring came with pussy willow, muscari (grape hyacinth), chinadoxa, daffodils and deep purple heather.

To complete the programme, Lesley gave us an elegant three-placement stand with arrangements of lilac freesia, pink tulips, white viburnum tinus and spray carnations, sweeping us gracefully into the lovely early English summer season. *Joan Tarmu, committee member*

During last month's Annual Parish Meeting there was an opportunity for community groups to tell the village all about what's been going on in Clophill over the last year. Around 40 villagers attended the event in the Village Hall – which was full of positivity, applause and goodwill.

CPC Chair Cllr Paul Downing began by talking about this year's personnel changes within Clophill Parish Council. He praised previous members and Clerk James Sterling's work on our communications platforms and the Council's administration. Cllr Downing also announced his intention to step down after May's Parish Council meeting.

Cllr GP Mantini provided an update on the **village Neighbourhood Plan**, thanking those who attended a recent NP event in the Village Hall, and those that filled out the recent online survey. The opportunity to assist on the project is still open to all. Cllr Louise Hodge spoke about the improvements that have been, and will be, taking place at **the recreation ground**.

Cllr Terry Lee confirmed that a new **CPC noticeboard** will be installed outside the Methodist Church in early May. Our longest-serving councillor, Ralph Brough, updated CPC 'highways' issues, including his expectations that the **speed-indicating device** we've been promised for the east of the village will soon be in place, together with a new pedestrian crossing at the Village Green.

The police were unable to make the meeting, but their written report indicated that Clophill was still **an area of low crime** – 61 recorded crimes in the past 12 months. That's an increase of 17 from the previous year, a trend we hope doesn't continue. Ward Councillors Paul Duckett and Mike Blair gave a general overview of Central Bedfordshire Council – including the pressures of a growing population and preserving 'quality of life' in the area.

Steve Langhorn, representing the **Village Hall**, mentioned the new website for the venue – *www.clophillvillagehall.com* – adding that the hall is a busy place and makes a small surplus which is spent on maintenance/improvements.

St Mary's Church was represented by Rosemary, who told the room about the challenges and successes for the church, and reminded us that the building was now 168 years old. John, from **Clophill Methodist Church**, talked about the success of the roofing project last summer, and the variety of activities that they host on their premises.

From Clophill United Charities, Julie Benson highlighted that £4000 had been paid to residents in need in the past year and also spoke about **Clophill Community Care**, explaining how they support villagers in need with a team of 49 volunteers. **Clophill Friends of Cheshire Home** were represented by John who told us about the great work they're doing to support disabled adults in the area.

Chris and Imogen from **Clophill Preschool** gave a visual presentation to illuminate how their organisation is far more than just local childcare. **Clophill Flower Club** was represented by Carolyn who entertained with the fantastic work they've been doing, and promoted their website – *www.clophillflowerclub.com*. **Clophill Heritage Trust** was represented by Ali Bradbury who described the variety of projects run in and around the Old Church and award-winning Eco Lodges in the past 12 months. And Duncan of **Clophill Utd FC** informed us there were now 50 members and they were voted the 'Best Run Club' in their league this year.






