

Hello there. Looking back to September, we had an amazing month. On the 27th – three years and four months after our first inspection – **Ofsted came to Preschool**. The inspector started by chatting to our parents and engaged with the children, later reporting that their 'behaviour is exceptional'.

She watched a dance class and a cookery session and commented that 'Children choose from a range of high-quality resources and exceptionally well-taught indoor and outdoor activities. Children play with a purpose. They become inventive and creative learners.'

No stone was left unturned in her scrutiny of our setting. In her feedback to us, the inspector told us that we'd achieved the grade of Outstanding. In fact she said that we excelled in every area. So no surprise that we burst into tears!

In the same week our new **Outdoor Learning Shelter** was passed by Building Regulations. The shelter was built by Gary Martin and Jake Banks in their free time and we'd like to officially thank them for all their hard work and generosity. What was a disused and derelict piece of land is now a fantastic learning space for children. Where we can, we've upcycled and repurposed – we even got our used grass from the tennis courts of Buckingham Palace!

We opened our shelter on Friday 13th October and invited children and parents as well as the very supportive Village Hall Committee and Parish Council. Our parents were as generous as ever in their supply of cakes and in helping us get the shelter ready. It was a really great event and so satisfying to watch all the children try out the shelter and its resources.

Since then we've been doing lots of play in the new area. We've made **fairy gardens and mud pies**, built dens and turned stones into hedgehogs. The children have been developing their arm muscles for writing by hammering nails into logs and they've been learning about what plants they can touch and ones that aren't safe.



In the meantime our fabulous parents and grandparents continue to support us, especially in our fundraising. Don't forget, we're always collecting for our Happy School Bags – just drop off to Preschool or get in touch if you'd like to donate your old clothes, shoes or bedding.

Clophill & District Flower Club

We were delighted to welcome back Theresa Rodrigues for our October meeting. A lady with an impressive flower arranging CV, this year Theresa gained her third Gold Medal at Chelsea and 'Best in Show'. We had high expectations for her **'What a Load of Rubbish'** demonstration for us – and we weren't disappointed.





During the evening Theresa's enthusiasm and design skills were very apparent, not only in her flower arranging but also in the creation of her containers and accessories. One such container was made using the technique of origami and after a lot of time spent trialling different qualities of old paper she said that the John Lewis Catalogue was best!

Other sources of 'rubbish' included an old tin covered in hessian and sprayed before adding manipulated lotus leaves that depicted ruffled cancan skirts. Then there was a bowl made out of papier-mâché and decorated with small tiles as well as interesting shapes cut from cardboard,

which were then glued together and decorated with wool and sisal.

For one of the evening's arrangements, Theresa recycled a container that she'd made for her first Chelsea exhibit. This incorporated a damaged tall glass vase which was then intricately decorated with contorted hazel, thin branches and moss. Within the structure Theresa had positioned a handmade mask made out of reconstituted moss.

As Theresa worked she explained the inspiration behind her displays. One was taken from her childhood memories of accompanying her father when he visited the family's rubber plantation, where she'd watch as



the rubber ran from the tree into a bowl. Another came from taking a cable car over the jungle – which left her with memories of large green tropical and structural foliage.

All six arrangements were very individual with a varied choice of flowers and foliage, including calla lilies, orchids, strelitzias and protea pin cushion. Theresa demonstrated how to cut and manipulate foliage to create different shapes, with each arrangement accompanied by her amusing and entertaining stories. The evening proved to be one of the highlights of the year. *Ann Dowding, committee member*

Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Bruschetta with Grilled Vegetables



INGREDIENTS Serves 4-6

- 1 medium aubergine
- 1 medium courgette
- 1 red pepper

- 1 yellow pepper
- balsamic vinegar

- extra virgin olive oil
- salt & freshly ground pepper
- flat-leaf parsley or rocket for decoration
- 4-6 slices of farmhouse style bread
- **1.** Wash and thinly slice the aubergine into rounds.
- **2.** Wash and thinly slice the courgette lengthwise.
- **3.** Wash and cut the peppers in half lengthwise and remove the seeds.
- **4.** Griddle all the vegetables and set aside.
- **5.** Slice the pepper halves into thin strips.
- **6.** Place all the vegetables in a bowl and season to taste.



- 7. Add 2 tbsp olive oil and 1 tbsp balsamic vinegar, mix well and allow to marinate.
- **8.** Slice the bread and griddle.
- 9. Top the bread with the griddled vegetables.
- **10.** Decorate with a sprig of parsley or rocket leaves.

You can use large slices of bread for a starter-size portion or make smaller pieces to serve as canapés.

There have been lots of conversations recently between authorities in Central Bedfordshire about the potential creation of **a dedicated cycle route that ends at Flitwick train station**. Clophill could potentially be a part of that route, if there is a desire for it. We'd be delighted to hear from potential users of such a cycle route – to get your views and opinions to help us when it comes to further consultation on this matter. Kerbside collection of household garden waste will be suspended across Central Bedfordshire over the winter months. The collections will be suspended from Monday 4 December 2017 until Friday 2 March 2018 inclusive. The decision to stop the kerbside collection service during the quietest time of the year for garden waste was made as part of Central Bedfordshire council's financial planning process, and comes as a result of Government funding cuts. Council Tax alone doesn't raise enough to cover all the services the council provides, and so the council focuses on delivering services that meet the periods of high demand, in this case restricting garden waste collections to during the growing season.

Mobile phone reception, in particular for O2 customers in the village, has been a hot topic this last month in Clophill. Many residents who used O2 had complained of a dramatically reduced level of phone reception since December 2016, but found that the service provider were not responding positively to the complaints. It all came to a head when BBC Three Counties Radio focused on the issue on their Breakfast show – which led to O2 sending out engineers to realign the antennae on October 12th. Following the work, O2 said: 'Our team tested the coverage levels at postcode MK45 4AH which have now significantly improved to make 2G, 3G and 4G calls. Hope that the customers have seen an improvement following this afternoon's work.'

Clophill Parish Council will continue to work with affected residents to monitor this situation – our view is that despite our village being rural, the telecoms providers should be responding to our issues as they would to more populous areas. We thank BBC Three Counties Radio and the villagers who led on this campaign for their support on this issue.
