## A tribute to Sylvia Joan Lammas

29th June 1932-20th January 2018

Sylvia Devonshire was born in Maulden, starting her life with her parents on a smallholding and this initiated her love of animals, birds and the countryside. While she was still at school in Maulden, Sylvia met her future husband Gerald Lammas. Sylvia spent and lived most of her life in Clophill. Initially she stayed with Kitty and George Lammas at 8 The Slade, including when she was first married in 1952. She moved with Gerald



to 10 The Slade and in 1959 they were joined by Christina. In 1964 the family moved to Shefford Road where Sylvia lived until she moved to be nearer Christina in August 2011.

Sylvia worked at the Royal Exchange in Bedford, Maulden Post Office, Rowland Fabrics in Ampthill and Silsoe College until she retired in 1994.

Throughout Sylvia's time in Clophill she was active in the community. She was a member of the WI, the Fete and Village Hall Committee. Later she was invited to be a Parish Councillor, a role she undertook for 20 years and she took responsibility as Chair of the Lands and Highways Committee. Additionally, as part of her role as a Councillor she was a School Governor

and she thoroughly enjoyed being involved in Clophill Lower School. Sylvia also delivered Spotlight and collected for the Annual Poppy Campaign at her end of the village.

Later in life Sylvia also joined the WRVS and was then a Volunteer at Bedford Hospital, which involved her serving and then helping feed patients who had had a stroke. She enjoyed her many community roles into her seventies.

Many in the village will remember Sylvia and her bike. She was an ardent cyclist, biking regularly to Bedford, Ampthill, Silsoe, Maulden and around the village. Sylvia enjoyed her garden and became an intrepid traveller on her own from 1979.

Even though Sylvia moved she didn't lose contact with what was happening within the village. Spotlight was posted to her, which she shared with Christina. Sylvia was a kind, caring, hard-working lady who enjoyed life and did a lot of good work for others, and is much missed by her family and indeed by the community of Clophill.

#### Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

Now is the best time of year to start pruning shrubs that flower in late summer and autumn. Pruning each year, in the spring, will give a much



better display of flowers and will keep the plant from getting too big and improve the overall plant health. Shrubs that bloom after mid-summer usually produce flowers at the end of this season's growth, so pruning in early to mid-spring allows time for the new growth to mature and flower in the same year. Butterfly bush (Buddleja), smoke bush (Cotinus), St Johns Wort (Hypericum) and winter flowering heathers are just some of the shrubs that respond really well to being pruned now.



Using clean, sharp secateurs. cut back the previous year's flowering stems to within one or two buds of the older woodv framework and at the same time remove any thin, weak or dead growth. Make sure you cut at an angle, above the buds. This stimulates the development of strong new growth which will produce your flowers.

When some shrubs are pruned hard, they regrow vigorously, producing more colourful stems that brighten up the garden in winter. Examples include dogwood (Cornus), willow (Salix) and ornamental bramble (Rubus). Others can also be hard-pruned for their decorative leaves, including: Indian bean tree (Catalpa), Eucalyptus and elder (Sambucus). Willows and dogwoods respond well to annual pruning and put lots of new young growth on, which will give you lots of winter stem colour.

**Early-flowering shrubs are pruned after flowering** (late winter to early summer, depending on the shrub). These usually flower on the previous year's growth so pruning immediately after flowering allows the maximum time for development of young growth to provide the following year's flowers before the end of summer. Examples are flowering currant (Ribes), Forsythia, mock orange (Philadelphus) and Weigela. If you prune these shrubs now you won't get any flowers – so leave these until May or June.

Remove any frost-damaged shoots from evergreen shrubs damaged by the cold weather and cut out any plain green shoots on hardy variegated evergreens, to prevent reversion taking over. Lightly cut back lavenders, Helichrysum (curry plant), Santolina (cotton lavender), thyme and rosemary plants to prevent them getting too leggy and woody.

As for feeding and mulching, feed with a granular feed or pelleted chicken manure before mulching around your shrubs with a 5-8cm (2-3in) layer of organic matter. This will help retain moisture, reduce weed build-up and improve our sandy soil. Pay particular attention to mulching around rhododendrons, azaleas and camellias, as flowering is poor if these get too dry during late summer.

Next month I'll be looking at all things edible!

#### Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

# Spaghetti with Tuna Sauce



#### **INGREDIENTS** Serves 4 people

- 1 x 150g tin of tuna in olive oil
- 1 x 400g tin of chopped tomatoes
- spaghetti x 350g

• 3 branches of fresh basil

- 3 cloves of garlic, peeled
- ½ tsp chilli flakes
- 2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- salt and freshly ground pepper



- 1. Bring to the boil a large pan of salted water.
- 2. Gently heat the olive oil in a deep frying pan.
- **3.** Fry the chilli flakes and whole cloves of garlic until the garlic is golden brown.
- **4.** Add the tin of tomatoes and season to taste.
- 5. Simmer for about 15 mins.
- **6.** In the meantime, cook the spaghetti for approx mins until al dente.
- 7. Add the flaked tuna to the sauce and mix well.
- **8.** Drain the pasta, add to the sauce and toss well.
- 9. Remove the basil leaves from the stalk, roughly chop and add to the spaghetti.

## **Clophill Parish Council**

These notes are a resume only. Official minutes are available on the internet and notice boards. All official correspondence should be sent to the parish clerk and not individual councillors.

Thanks to everyone who came along to our March meeting. Here are some of the highlights: Five Grant Aid requests were carefully reviewed by a working party prior to being presented and then voted on by the wider Parish Council at the meeting.

- Citizen Advice was awarded £200 for their important outreach work which supports vulnerable residents in Central Bedfordshire. In the past year they've supported two people who live in Clophill.
- 9th Ampthill & Woburn (Badger Hill) Scout Group was awarded £550. They provide great opportunities for 6-25 year olds living in Clophill, Maulden, Gravenhurst, Silsoe, Pulloxhill, Houghton Conquest and Ampthill. The group are looking to reach a target of £5,700 to improve their meeting hut and to provide a metal storage container and an improved area for camp fires.
- St Marys Church requested a contribution towards the £2,200 required to make some timely repairs to the Tower Belfry roof. The church is a listed building central to village life and can be used by all Parishioners. £550 has already been raised towards this project. An award of (up to) £1,650 was made.
- **Clophill United** was awarded £600. The club currently runs five teams for players who live in Clophill and surrounding villages and the club is expanding. We recognise that it's very positive that young people have the opportunity to play locally and that the club is organised by a committed group of volunteers, which is very commendable.
- Clophill Pre-School requested assistance to find an area of Parish Council-owned land to improve their 'Forest School' offer and also funding to both increase an area of patio and to permanently fence their overall outdoor area. A small piece of lightly wooded Parish Council land has been made available and an award of £1,500 was made.

**Demonstration of defibrillators** Clophill Parish Council has asked The Community Heartbeat Trust (CHT) to present and demonstrate the use of defibrillators, such as the ones installed at the Post Office and Village Hall, on the 17th April in the Village Hall at 7pm. CHT will be explaining how the equipment works and its benefits to the community in saving precious minutes in the treatment of sudden cardiac arrest. Everybody is welcome, and no special skills are required.

**Speeding update** The Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) on Shefford Road is set to be replaced by a Speed Indicator Device (SID) in May this year. We hope that this development will help deter speeding through the east entrance to our village. We look forward to meeting SID and will keep you updated when he arrives!

**Parish Council vacancy** There's still a vacancy at Clophill Parish Council. This is an unpaid role that involves attending meetings once a month and spending an hour or so a week reviewing and responding to information. Training will be given.
