Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Seafood Salad



INGREDIENTS Serves 4-6

- 300g fresh mussels in the shell, cleaned
- 4 squid (bodies and tentacles)
- 8 large uncooked, shelled prawns
- 100g marinated anchovies
- 1 small carrot
- 1 stick of celery

- 1 cup white wine vinegar
- 1 unwaxed lemon
- small bunch flat leaf parsley
- extra virgin olive oil
- salt and freshly ground pepper



- **1.** Bring 2lts of water to the boil and add in the cup of white wine vinegar and a pinch of sea salt.
- **2.** Slice the carrot and celery stick very thinly into rounds (use a mandolin if you have one).
- 3. Blanch the carrot and celery in the stock for 5 mins.
- 4. Remove with a slotted spoon and set aside to cool.
- 5. Thinly slice the squid into rounds but leave the tentacles whole.
- **6.** Poach the squid in the same liquid for about 5 mins then remove with a slotted spoon and set aside to cool.
- 7. Slice the marinated anchovies in half lengthways.
- **8.** Poach the shelled prawns for about 3 mins remove with a slotted spoon and set aside. When cool, slice in half lengthways.
- **9.** Poach the cleaned mussels until they've opened then remove from the liquid. When cool enough to handle remove the mussels from the shells.
- **10.** Place everything into a large bowl season with lemon juice, olive oil and black pepper and sprinkle with coarsely chopped flat leaf parsley.
- Can't find an unwaxed lemon? Run your whole lemon under warm water and then wipe thoroughly with kitchen paper to remove any wax that might have been used during the packaging process.

For the past 10 years Clophill resident Carl Colyer has been putting on an annual Christmas light show to raise money for charity. And in 2017 he raised **a record £725** – which will be donated to **Dreams Come True**, a charity that helps children and young people with serious and life-limiting conditions to fulfil a dream.

'It takes me about six week to set up the display and it's not as easy as it looks,' says Carl, who has raised about £5,000 for charity, including the East Anglian Air Ambulance. 'There's so much to do, with over 300 plugs and around 6,000 bulbs. You have to make sure there's enough power and it's all tested and everything is working.'

A belated happy new year to everyone in the village from Clophill Parish Council. Our January meeting was a busy one, with lots of talking points.

Cllr Austin recently attended the VCSE forum run by Central Bedfordshire Council. The purpose of the meeting was to find out how relevant organisations can apply for funding from the **Community Grant Scheme**.

There is 100K available each year for three years. It's to be distributed in amounts of £200-£10,000 to community groups, charities, individuals, not-for-profit organisations and social enterprises. The fund will be used to support opportunities that will be considered against specific bid criteria and that will fulfil one of the following outcomes:

- people are able to live independently at home
- people are able to participate in their local community
- people are not socially isolated
- people feel safe, secure, valued and respected

Bids must be submitted by 16th February and the outcome of bids will be made available within a month. For further information and support to make bids, contact *wendy.austin@clophill-pc.gov.uk*
