



Remembering Clophill's Fallen

Continuing our series of the centenary of Clophill's brave men who lost their lives in the First World war....

July of 1917 brought news that Joseph Lomas and Bertram Harris had been killed in action aged 21 and 26 respectively.

In 1911 **Joseph Lomas** lived in Back Street with his parents, William and Sarah, and his 10 surviving siblings. He and his father were both labourers. He enlisted in 1914 and served with the 5th Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment as a Private. Joseph served with his brother, Jack; another brother, Charles, served, with the Beds Yeomanry – they both survived the War. Joseph's death is commemorated in Palestine.



In the period leading up to the eventual fall of Gaza in November 1917, the 5th Battalion of the Bedfordshire Regiment was assigned to conduct two major raids on Turkish positions in front of Gaza. They held the line opposite the Turkish positions on Umbrella Hill, which would be the target of their attentions. The Umbrella Hill raids would be so successful that all future raids in the theatre were executed in precisely the same way that the Bedfords conducted them on those two nights. Joseph lost his life during the second raid.

News of the Lomas brothers was regularly reported in Ampthill News and they sent several postcards home to their mother. Many thanks to Laura Sharp for providing the information and postcard.

Bertram Harris was born in Marston but by 1911 he was living at 'The Kiln' (now known as 6 Old Kiln Lane) in Clophill. He was a farm labourer and lived with his widowed father, James, a shepherd, and his nine-year-old brother. Their mother, Laura, had died in 1903. Bertram also had two older sisters. He enlisted in Lichfield and served Notts &



Derby Regiment and then with the 13th Battalion Alexandra, Princess of Wales's own (Yorkshire Regiment.) He's commemorated in the Fins New British Cemetery, Somme, France.

In 1917 the 13th Battalion saw action during The German retreat to the Hindenburg Line, the capture of Fifteen Ravine, Villers Plouich, Beaucamp and La Vacquerie and The Cambrai Operations. Fins is a village near Cambrai.

To end the week Angellica's dad, artist Paul, came and did some fantastic artworks with the children.



The children all made Father's Day cards with Chris and cut out shapes to collage pictures of their dad or grandad. Chris noticed that some of the children really struggled using the scissors so set up a cutting activity in the room for the next few days where they could snip at different things from straws to wool to help promote their skills.

We had another dad into Preschool, Terry – dad of Primrose – who came to do interviews with the children about what they like about preschool and their favourite things to do. We hope to get this together with some images so that we can post it to our website soon.

We're fundraising with the help of our fantastic parents and the wider community, and raised £163 with our **Happy Bags** to school last month. Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Rigatoni with Sicilian Cauliflower Sauce



INGREDIENTS Serves 4

- 500g rigatoni (or other short pasta)
- 1 medium cauliflower
- 1 medium onion, finely chopped
- 3 anchovy fillets

- salt & freshly ground black pepper
- 50g seedless raisins

- 50g pine nuts
- 30ml extra virgin olive oil
- 50g freshly grated parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp saffron filaments, soaked in a little warm water for about 10 mins
- 1. Put a large pan of salted water to the boil.
- 2. Wash the cauliflower and remove the green leaves and coarse part of the stalk.
- **3.** Cook whole in the boiling water until cooked but not too soft.
- 4. Remove from the water with a slotted spoon and retain the cooking water

5. In a large frying pan heat half of the olive oil and gently fry the onion until golden, then add the soaked saffron.

- **6.** Whilst the onion is cooking divide the cooked cauliflower into florettes and add to the onion.
- Heat the rest of the olive oil in a small pan and add in the anchovy fillets. Cook on a low heat until they've almost melted.
- 8. Add the anchovy to the cauliflower together with the seedless raisins and pine nuts. Mix well, season with black pepper, cover and move off the heat.
- **9.** Bring the cauliflower water to the boil and cook the pasta according to the directions on the packet.
- **10.** Drain the pasta and add it into the cauliflower sauce.
- **11.** Turn into a heated serving dish and sprinkle with the grated parmesan.



DID YOU KNOW? Many Sicilian recipes contain raisins and pine nuts due to the centuries of Arab occupation.

Fundraising for St Mary's School new nursery build

The Governors of St Mary's CoE Lower School in Clophill have to raise £20,000 contribution towards the new nursery build.

This building will be the new home of Acorn class which accommodates pre-school children aged 2, 3 and 4 years old. This will have an incredibly positive impact on the school as it will provide a beautiful bespoke space for Acorn Nursery as well as enabling all of the classes to move back to their original classrooms. Acorn Nursery will be able to welcome parents who wish to take up 30 hours free entitlement in September and, of course, the Nursery children also have access to the breakfast and afterschool club, Funzone.

Work on the building is underway and will be completed during the summer. It will be ready for the new school year in September and will be officially opened and blessed in September by the Bishop of Bedford.

There are a number of fundraising initiatives underway to **help raise the £20,000 needed**, and we'd like to invite all in the village to get involved and have some fun!

The children have already participated in a sponsored times table challenge and the families at the school were also offered the opportunity to sign the underside of the roof tiles which have been put onto the new nursery building, meaning that their names will be incorporated



into the new build for its lifetime. These two events have raised £700 between them.

Annual Report May 2017



Summary of 2016-2017

The year ending May 2017 has been another excellent year for the Village Hall.

The Committee can report an excellent year in terms of its financial performance. We've continued with our policy of controlling costs tightly and building high occupancy levels at the hall to drive revenue.

As a result of this strong financial performance we've been able record a small surplus which we can reinvest in the hall to maintain and upgrade our offering to users. We've moved quickly to invest these funds in the following ways:

- we've purchased a new CCTV Hub to help protect the hall and grounds
- exterior lighting has been completely overhauled to provide better safety for users
- the cooker, which had been causing some problems, has been fully serviced and repaired
- although not directly funded from this year's surplus, we've launched a new website, www.clophillvillagehall.com, which includes a 'virtual tour' of the hall so prospective hirers can 'look around' prior to making enquires.

We'll continue to invest wisely to maintain and continually improve our standards.

We'd like to thank Colin Carpenter who's kindly donating a Copper Beech tree to replace the one in front of the hall that was vandalised. The original tree had been planted to celebrate the 2012 Diamond Jubilee

We've only conducted one fundraiser this last year – the Santa Sleigh – which was really well received by the families in the village. In a way, it's very good news that we can run the hall at a small surplus without having to run too many fundraising events as it demonstrates that the ongoing hiring of the hall is operating at such a level that we can make a bit more than breakeven at the end of the year. Indeed, we are now at key times getting to maximum utilisation of all our facilities and special mention must go to our Booking Secretary, Marilyn Browning, who does a great job at helping meet hirers needs and managing a very busy booking diary.

A customary thank you goes to all members of the Village Hall Management Committee for all their hard work and personal time devoted to the upkeep of the hall. Our Committee is quite small in size with only eight members so the burden of running the hall falls on just a few very willing shoulders. We'd welcome some new members to spread the load and maybe bring some new ideas – if you're interested please call me on *07831 255807*

- support the Pre-School Group, in particular to sustain and build their excellent operation
- expand the Village Hall Management Committee membership

News from Rotary Club





One of the great features of being a member of the Rotary Club is the opportunity to listen to some amazing talks on a wide range of subjects. Many are truly inspirational as they deal with the efforts and achievements of both individuals and groups seeking to deliver service and support for the disadvantaged.

One such talk was given recently by Steve Finney and Andrew Mann, both members of the Dunstable and District Disabled Sports Society (DADDS). Steve has great difficulty in walking and uses a wheeled frame to get around; Andy has lost both legs below the knee and uses artificial limbs. They explained that DADDS was set up in the 1990s to provide an opportunity for people like themselves to take part in sports against each other or, where appropriate, to compete against able-bodied people.



The focus of their talk was shooting, as both are enthusiastic shots using either air guns or pistols. They demonstrated the equipment necessary for them to be able to fire accurately and consistently at very small targets some 10m away. This included specially adapted guns to help people who may have physical or sight disability as well as special, very well-tailored jackets to enable people like Andy to be sufficiently well balanced to hold and fire a rifle accurately. Using the accepted measure for shooting both are very good indeed with Steve rated at 95 and Andy at 85 out of 100.

Thanks to the facilities and support offered by DADDS it has enabled both Steve and Andy to compete in competitions at Bisley on a comparable footing to able-bodied shooters and it has clearly been a tremendous boost to their morale and confidence.

Club members really enjoyed the lively and enthusiastic presentation, which gave us the opportunity to have a hands-on experience with such interesting props.

With the warmer weather in full swing, Clophill Parish Council is certainly not in 'summer holiday' mode quite yet. Indeed our June meeting was packed to the rafters with plenty of items discussed.

Top of the agenda is CBC's decision to unanimously approve the hybrid planning application by **Gallagher Estates at the Lakes**. Full permission was granted to 'develop' outdoor parkland space and outline permission was granted to develop up to 50 dwellings. The two are intrinsically linked and the housing can't be developed until the parkland is delivered.

The decision was made after representations from CPC, CAUSE and Gallaghers (GE). A lengthy debate ensued centring on a raft of conditions and public/minuted assurances from GE that ALL land outside of the housing area will transfer. CPC will be firmly involved alongside ward councillors and CBC to ensure the project is delivered in accordance with the developer's promises. Thanks to Cllrs Walford and Austin for getting around 40 residents along to Chicksands, which was noted by the Committee.

Hamblin Estates has submitted a second application to develop up to 51 houses at the former **Readshill Quarry**. CPC is grateful to residents who have been proactive in raising the profile of this application. If granted the resulting traffic increase in Readshill, Cainhoe Road, Back Street and Mill Lane would be seriously problematic and dangerous. Please **GET INVOLVED** if you don't want to see this happen.

CBC has published its **Local Plan** which is open for consultation between 4 July and 29 August 2017. It's this document that informs developers about what is likely to be permitted. Anyone can attend an event on 18th July at Chicksands or for more information go to http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/planning/policy/local-plan/local-plan.aspx

Cllr Brough hosted a visit from **CBC Highways** in June when along with Cllr Mantini and Ward Cllr Downing the issues affecting Clophill were highlighted and subsequently noted in a letter to CBC.

The Rec area, and specifically the improvements that are being made to it, are something that we're receiving a lot of feedback on at the moment – thank you for that. At the time of writing only the new slide is yet to be open for the public as we wait for the new turf that surrounds the area to become safe and secure for little feet to run on

Two new benches are now in place near the play equipment. One is in memory of David Myers, who served as Chairman and Footpaths Officer to Clophill Parish Council for over 20 years. The other bench was donated to the village by NextDoor – a free private social network for Clophill.

Unfortunately, Clophill suffers from a small amount of **anti-social behaviour** and the PC would encourage collective social responsibility by all to ensure this doesn't get out of hand.
