Bedfordshire Bus Services Consultation 2016

Central Bedfordshire Council (CBC) has issued a public consultation document about how they plan to reduce the amount of money they pay for bus services.

- 45 of the 85 bus services receive an operating subsidy.* (£1.2m per year)
- there are 43,000 Concessionary Pass holders
- 40% of bus journeys are made using a pass and (CBC) pays the fare. (£2.4m per year)

Key issues from the new proposals

- subsidies will be limited to routes with the highest demand
- subsidies limited to 8am to 6.30pm (Saturday 3pm). No subsidies on Sunday
- <u>Concessionary Passes only between 09:30 and 23:00</u> And all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays
- no automatic renewal of Concessionary Passes
- pass application and renewal only to be available online

Have your say by seeing the full consultation document and completing the response form, both available from a library or online – www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk then go to 'Consultations'.

How does this affect your Flittabus?

* Flittabus Your Community Bus, run and driven by unpaid volunteers, <u>receives no</u> <u>operating subsidy from CBC</u>, but has in the past received grants towards the cost of new buses.

Flittabus can be used by anyone and we also accept Concessionary Passes.

Flittabus's main income is payment when Concessionary Passes are used, paid by CBC, Beds Borough & MK Councils. Without these payments Flittabus couldn't operate as it does. Eight of the eleven Flittabus services start their run before 09:30, so we're asking CBC to exempt Flittabus from the ban on passes before 09:30.

If you want your existing Flittabus services to continue please support us by answering the consultation and saying Flittabus should be exempt from the 'no passes before 09:30 rule'. There is a possible provision for this within the plan. Or you can email you comments to susan.childerhouse@centralbedfordshire.gov.uk

Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Pan-fried Cod with Fennel Puree

INGREDIENTS Serves 4-6 people

- 1 large fillet of cod
- 8 slices of pancetta or streaky bacon
- 3-4 fennel bulbs

- extra virgin olive oil
- bunch of fresh sage
- salt & freshly ground black pepper
- 1. Roughly chop 2-3 of the fennel bulbs and poach until tender.
- 2. Retain the dark green fennel fronds for decoration.
- 3. Liquidise the cooked fennel to obtain a puree – season to taste.
- 4. Cut the cod loin into 2inch size pieces and wrap each one with $\frac{1}{2}$ slice of pancetta.
- 5. Pan fry these gently in a little olive oil and a few sage leaves until cooked through.
- **6.** Thinly slice the remaining fennel into shreds (use a mandolin if you have one).
- 7. Put a mound of the fennel puree onto warm individual serving plates.
- **8.** Place the cod on top of the puree and top with the raw fennel shavings.
- **9.** Decorate with the dark green fennel fronds.

Hi everyone! Our children have been having a fantastic time outdoors in the lovely weather. We do end up with a lot of soggy socks but the water play allows them to learn so much and is a great way to cool down in the heat.

We've poured water into trays for them to paddle in, we've used running water to float boats down

guttering and we've discussed water animals like sting rays and frogs. The children have also **had a lot of fun making 'potions'** with tinted water, washing windows and using roller and paintbrushes to mark-make on the patio.

And the children have been learning about life cycles: frogs and butterflies have been acted out, coloured in and constructed. We've also made a board for our human life cycles using photos of the children and their families.

We had a lovely time at the Church Fete. Lots of people visited our stall, where we had free play dough for the children to use and **a lucky dip treasure chest**. Chris filled her car with balloons – a lot more difficult than it sounds! – and people guessed how many we managed to get into it. Well done to Ralph Neuff for winning with a guess of 200 – pretty close to our 187!

The children love writing letters and cards and 'posting' them. It's a great way to develop mark making and writing skills and brings up lots of discussion about holidays and birthdays, so we've bought a post box to enhance our role play area.

By combining the money raised from the Egg Hunt and the recent Church Fete we've bought a pop-up gazebo, a small pop-up tent, orchard puzzles and games, some cylinders of different sizes for water play and a set of specialised child-friendly knives for when the children prepare snacks with Janine. With the money raised from our Egg Hunt **we were able to donate £50 to Keech Cottage Children's Hospice**, plus we raised £41 for Sport Relief when we did our sponsored running round the field every day for a week. The one major negative is that this time of year attracts swimmers to our 'lakes' site – a site in which a teenager tragically drowned last July. Nobody in our village would want to see a similar incident happen again.

Last month, Bedfordshire Fire and Rescue Service launched a new county-wide campaign, called 'It's Colder Than It Looks', to **warn people of the dangers of open-water swimming**. So we feel it's time to reiterate our own message. Over the next couple of months, Clophill Parish Council would appreciate extra vigilance from all parishioners, particularly from High Street residents who live opposite the footpath to Castle Hill. We'd also appreciate vigilance from walkers using the footpath to Castle Hill, who may notice where the fence has been broken down or damaged.

If you see people on their way to the site, or anything else that's suspicious, call the police on 101 – the non-emergency police number. We're quite sure they will much prefer being called in to investigate the safety of the site, rather than a rescue operation from the lake.

So please look out for:

- Gatherings of cars, motorbikes or other vehicles around the High Street area opposite the footpath to Castle Hill.
- Groups of young people playing loud music.
- Damaged or broken fences in the footpath to Castle Hill.

Clophill's Neighbourhood Plan (NP) now exists in document form, although it's in the very early stages of drafting. It has highlighted a number of areas which we, as a community, need to undertake additional work on. CPC's NP team are eager to involve more people in collaborating on this very important project which will help steer the direction of the village development for the next 25 years. Central Bedfordshire Council has included a proposal we made for **improvements to parking and pedestrian safety** at the Village Green in their own plans. This includes the provision of a pedestrian crossing from a point on the South side of the High Street to the North side outside the Green Man restaurant. The plan also includes a review of the village green parking arrangements. Funding for this work will be shared between CBC and the Parish Council. More information on this development as we receive it.

Thank you to David Davies of Davies Stephenson Partnership based in Gravenhurst for **surveying our recreation ground** free of charge. This has been extremely helpful as we look to develop our plans to update the area and the play equipment.
