## Clophill through the years

## Real Highwaymen at the Flying Horse

The legend of Dick Turpin may be a myth but there were highwaymen at the Flying Horse in 1751. On the day of Ampthill Fair, 21st April, three men came to the Flying Horse where the publican was Abraham Perrin. They pretended to be horse dealers who travelled from fair to fair. They spoke of their fear of highwaymen. They spent a total of twelve shillings on themselves, including



malt liquor and hot punch, before going to bed, and stabling for their horses.

After staying the night, they rode off at six in the morning for Ampthill where they probably stayed for a few hours. By eleven o'clock they had reached a public house in Houghton Conquest, probably the Butcher's Arms, later the Knife and Cleaver. There they had **cold roast beef for breakfast** and enquired what they could have for dinner. The landlady told them that she had a sheep hanging up in the shop but as her husband, the butcher, was away at Ampthill Fair she was unable to cut it up. One of the three men said that he would take off a shoulder which he did very skilfully.

About four o'clock they left and started **robbing travellers on the Ampthill to Bedford road** near Houghton Conquest. One of them had a blunderbuss with which he threatened people and they robbed four people of a total of £37 14s. When the robbed people arrived at Bedford they reported the crimes and a hue and cry reached Silsoe at six o'clock the next morning.

In the meantime the robbers had ridden to the Ampthill–Woburn road near Millbrook and robbed two farmers of about £30 and a joiner of a few shillings and his watch. At about nine o'clock they called at an ale house in Maulden and each drank a glass of gin. Then on to the George at Silsoe where they stayed on horseback whilst they **drank three pints of wine** and ate a crust of bread.

When they had travelled about a quarter of a mile, the one who had butchered the sheep was **shot in the back with the blunderbuss**. He was then dragged through a gate and shot in the head with a pistol. A farmer from Barton who rode by reported that he had heard the gun shots but had thought that it was somebody shooting pigeons.

The Toll-Gate man says the farmer had not passed two minutes before the highwayman came. The first horse that came was the horse of the man shot, which the Toll gate man would have turned back, but the men bade him let pass, they would pay for him. They seemed in much haste, but stayed to take their change.

The horse was later found in Luton. The owner said that the man who had stolen the horse, and later died, had been a servant of his. Why the other two highway men had killed him or whether they were captured is not known.

The above is based on a transcript of a letter from Philip Birt, vicar of Flitton, to Philip Yorke, 2nd Earl of Hardwicke, husband of Jemima, Marchioness Grey, by Mary Phillips (the author of The Clophill Story) held in the Bedfordshire and Luton Archives and Records Office, reference CRT100/27/3, as is the photo, reference Z1306/31.

## Our Value for November is Peace

We've chosen to teach this in November as we felt it was important to consider peace when learning about Remembrance Day. This may be a good place to start discussions with your child should you wish to. Perhaps you could think about why we have poppies.

You may also want to consider this:

**External Peace** is a state of harmony where there is a lack of conflict. This can be in relationships with others and also in the world around us. Peace evokes the presence of cultural understanding and unity. In order for people to truly be at peace, they must be open to others. What stops us being at peace? What reasons are there to be selfish, greedy, cruel etc? What teaches us to be kind and tolerant?

**Inner Peace** is found within – contentment with who we are and what we have. You may wish to talk to your child about whether they have a special place they can sit quietly and think. Why do we need to be quiet and peaceful sometimes? How do they feel when they are guiet and peaceful?

#### Music Lessons in School

We've always been a musical school but we've recently extended our provision by offering our children the opportunity to learn to play a variety of musical instruments. The children can now learn to play the piano, keyboard, violin, guitar, recorder and drums.

To celebrate our children's interest in music we hold a termly 'Afternoon Teatime Concert' complete with china cups and homemade cakes for parents attending the children's recital. In October the School Choir was also invited to complete our musical event. This has become a very popular concert for the children, their music teachers and parents – a tradition started by one of our governors, Mrs Jolin Crannis. Firstly we'd like to apologise for not having our usual article in Spotlight last month – unfortunately, there was a 'technical problem'. So a late thank you to all those who voted for the scarecrow we made together with the Toddlers Group as we won second prize!

We've had a lot going on at Preschool recently and we're making use of great connections within the village as well as making some new ones. A local lady came to do **song time** with our children. She played the ukulele which the children enjoyed listening to and joining in with. She's gone away with a list from the children of new songs to learn, and we all hope she'll be a regular visitor.

We also had our friend Natasha bring in a **collection of animals**. She talked about how to care and look after them, the kind of things they eat and showed the children how to handle them. We had a tortoise, stick insects, guinea pigs, giant African land snails and a budgie. But the favourite with all of the children was **Millie the dog**, who demonstrated how she could roll over and sit. We



all took Millie for a walk around the hall and the allotments, much to the children's delight.

Not only have we been lucky enough to have all these interesting visitors but we've been very fortunate to have been given quite a few donations – from toys to tyres! – for the Preschool. ## **News from Clophill Heritage Trust**

The restoration work being carried out by Universal Stone on St Mary's Old Church is progressing well and at a recent meeting with the architects and conservation bodies it was agreed to further improve the historic amenity by incorporating a 2nd viewing platform at the level of the belfry window, with a spiral staircase leading up to a roof-level platform. This was in large part necessitated by the narrow, irregular and poor condition of the

steps at the top of the tower, which only recently became evident upon close inspection.

Additional security is now in force through installation of flood lighting, passive infra red detectors, cctv plus an alarm system. The plight, arising from vandalism of St Marys Old church plus other properties receiving funding from English Heritage, was recently featured on the BBC 1 programme Street Patrol UK, presented by Dom Littlewood.

Across the path in the Clophill Ecolodge we're pleased that new full-time residential wardens have taken up occupation following completion and furnishing of the residential unit.

Also at the end of October, some 50 youngsters from St Mary's lower school visited the site on a seed-collecting activity, learning to identify different hedgerow plants such as blackthorn, hawthorn and wild rose through collection. The seeds will be taken to the Community Tree Trust site by the A6 roundabout for planting and will later be 'harvested' as saplings for deployment elsewhere.

Gathering chestnuts

Autumn has finally arrived, bringing with it an abundance of mushrooms (thanks to the wet weather we've been having) and chestnuts (freely available along the verges of the A6). So I'd like to share with you this mouthwatering hearty risotto which can be served as a starter or as a main course.



#### RISOTTO CON FUNGHI, CASTAGNE E PANCETTA (Risotto with mushrooms, chestnuts and pancetta)

- 300g arborio rice
- 300g mixed forest mushrooms 120ml dry white wine
- 300g whole chestnuts
- 1.25 It of vegetable stock (fresh or cube)
- 1 small shallot
- 80g pancetta or streaky bacon
- knob of butter
- extra virgin olive oil

- salt & freshly ground black pepper
- 2tbsp freshly grated parmesan cheese

#### Serves 4 people, or 6 as a starter

- **1.** Put a small slit in each chestnut then boil in water until they're tender. Peel, remove the inner furry skin and then roughly chop them.
- **2.** Clean the mushrooms with a paper towel (never wash mushrooms as they're already 80% water) then chop.
- **3.** Finely chop the shallot and put in a saucepan with 2tbsp olive oil together with the cubed pancetta.
- **4.** Fry for 2 minutes until the shallot is tender but not browned then add in the chopped mushrooms. Continue to fry gently for a further 2 minutes until all the flavours come together.
- **5.** Add in the rice and continue to stir until the rice has absorbed all the flavours.
- **6.** Deglaze the pan with the white wine and when this has been absorbed add in 2 ladles of the hot vegetable stock.
- **7.** Continue to stir the rice until all the stock has been absorbed and then continue to add the stock one ladle at a time until the rice is cooked. It should still have a bite to it and be 'al dente'.
- **8.** Adjust the seasoning to taste, then add in the chestnuts, knob of butter and parmesan cheese and stir until you have a creamy risotto.
- 9. Serve immediately Buon Apetito!

This month, our reporter Aoife Mantini has been chatting to body painter Alex Saunders







Alex Saunders

It all started many years ago when I was working in a fancy dress hire shop in Ampthill. While I was there I got trained up to do face painting, and when someone suggested I had a go at body painting, that was it.

I've worked in amateur dramatics, corporate entertainment and with living statues in Covent Garden. And recently I was involved with the movie *Crystal of the Gods* and the sequel *Destiny of the Crystal*, which is currently in production. I also recreate injuries to help with training at Luton & Dunstable Hospital.

Body painting is much more recognised and established in Europe, so I helped start the British Body Painting Society to raise its profile here. I competed in the World Championships in Austria, and ranked highly in my category of brushes and sponge.

I got a really good review in the Times and Citizen for that. They wrote: 'People have often remarked that the human body is a work of art but Alex Saunders takes things one step further, turning the human form into his canvas and easel.'

Competing is expensive though. It's not just the travel – the materials are pricey as well. I'd really need a corporate sponsor to do more.

Alex will be giving a demonstration of his talent in St Mary's Church in the New Year. He's also planning to compete at Paint Topia in Norwich next year.

The cyclone

Joanne quickly filled a basket with assorted foliage and blue/ pink flowers which she explained would be carried by Dorothy as she started her adventure. To interpret the cyclone, Joanne coiled bear grass around a tall cylindrical glass container and proceeded to arrange white flowers and coils of bear grass into small sprigs of euonymus on a dome of oasis placed on top of the container.

#### Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on 29th October 2013

**Public Question Time** – There were no questions.

#### **Police Report**

The council received a report from Bedfordshire Police regarding crime within the village. Once again there was a very low level of reported crime. Remember by working together we can keep crime at bay. If you see something suspicious, phone the police immediately. Keep your homes, garages and cars secure at all times. Dark and longer nights give more opportunity to thieves. You can get free impartial advice from Bedfordshire Police on all crime prevention matters.

#### **Vacancy for Parish Councillor**

Kate Breed, as you may, recall stepped down from the parish council a couple of years ago due to other commitments. She (and two other villagers) applied for the vacancy, Kate was accepted as a new parish councillor for the village of Clophill. The parish council extends a warm welcome and looks forward to working with her again.

#### The Lands Committees

- Our lighting contractor has now completed remedial work to the street lights in The Causeway. The lighting appears much improved from its previous state.
- The parish council has now made a complaint to the Highways Department regarding the poor state of some of our roadways in the village. There are potholes etc that need urgent repair.
- After consultation with local residents, funds have been allocated for a further street light to be placed at the far end of The Slade.
- The agreement for the permissive path from the Old Church Path across Pine Hill has been completed. The path can't be officially opened at the moment as a tenant has been requested to repair his stock fencing, and until this is done animals may be vulnerable.
- The right of way matter concerning Hay Close is hoped to be resolved in the next few months. Solicitors on both sides are working towards a solution.
- Although the parish council formally agreed a contract for the removal of the redundant bridge at The Green, problems have arisen concerning the diverting of power cables for the village that this bridge currently carries. Until a solution can be found this work can't be completed.
- Remedial work to trees on The Green has now taken place. Steve Dear's firm has done a wonderful job of cutting back the trees while maintaining the areas 'good looks'. It was all done on a weekday without interrupting the traffic flow. Many villagers have given complimentary views about 'our centre piece' and the parish council is happy to add its thanks for the good work done.

#### The Bobby Scheme

This scheme is run by Bedfordshire Police and assists those who need security advice and free security hardware, such as security chains for doors etc. There have been a number of residents who've used this important service and the parish council was happy to continue its support by donating £100.

#### The Lakes Site

During my frequent walks through the village I've often been asked what's happening regarding the




