Finally, we'd just like to make all parents aware of the **funding available** to children:

3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours of free childcare per week.

You can start claiming free childcare after your child turns three. The date you can claim will depend on when their birthday is:

Child's birthday	When you can claim
1 January to 31 March	The beginning of term on or after 1 April
1 April to 31 August	The beginning of term on or after 1 September
1 September to 31 December	The beginning of term on or after 1 January

2 year olds – to claim 15 hours per week free childcare you must be getting one of the following:

- income support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- Child Tax Credit and/or Working Tax Credit and have an annual income under £16,190
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit

Children are also entitled to a place if:

- they're looked after by a local council
- they have a current statement of special education needs (SEN) or an education health and care plan
- they get Disability Living Allowance
- they've left care under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order

Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe Turkey Escalopes with Lemon and White Wine



INGREDIENTS Serves 4

- 4 large turkey escalopes
- 10g butter

- juice of 1 unwaxed lemon
- 2 tbsp plain flour

- 1/4 tsp of freshly grated nutmeg
- small glass of dry white wine
- splash of extra virgin olive oil
- salt & freshly ground black pepper
- 1. Remove any excess skin and fat from the turkey escalopes, then cover with clingfilm and beat with a rolling pin until nice and thin.
- **2.** Season to taste and dust with the flour, shaking off any excess.
- **3.** Heat the oil and butter in a frying pan over a moderate heat, then gently fry the turkey escalopes on both sides until golden. Remove and set aside.
- **4.** Add the white wine, lemon juice and nutmeg to the frying pan then deglaze the pan.
- **5.** Once the juices have reduced by half put the escalopes back in and reheat.
- 6. Adjust the seasoning if necessary.
- **7.** Serve with new potatoes or just a fresh green salad.
- If you can't find an unwaxed lemon, run your whole lemon under warm water and clean thoroughly with kitchen paper to remove any wax that may have been used during packaging.

Clophill & District Flower Club





Our September meeting with National Demonstrator Julia Knight was a very enjoyable evening. Julia had just passed her demonstrator qualifications and shared some of her test arrangements, entitled 'Hello Broadway', with us.

We began with **'Chorus Line'**, a container lined with yellow and green foliages. Yellow roses represented dancers and a yellow taxi, while apples indicated the Big Apple. Julia's second arrangement had wood, shaped to resemble 'Crag Rock' from the Lion King. There was palm foliage for jungle, strelitzia (bird of paradise) to resemble leaping gazelles and, in the foreground, monstera leaves

and pink protea from South Africa. Branches of pieris, bronzed leaves and lotus seed heads completed the design. **'Singing in the Rain'** followed, with a lamp post plu phormium leaves and pittosporum to show water cascades and raindrops, green antheriums, centrally placed pink hydrangea and several small heads placed in suspended glass splash droplets. Pale pink carnations and umbrella completed the arrangements.

We were treated to **'Phantom of the Opera'** with a candled foliage wreath, fagus (copper beech), grouped dark heuchera leaves and pale pink champagne roses, plus the addition of two masks to add to the effect. A visit to **'My Fair Lady'** followed showing Eliza Doolittle's hat. A large shape made of woven birch twigs was complemented with a trim of ferns for feathers, snowberry sprays, white hydrangea lilies, sweetpeas and avalanche roses, as well as delicate asparagus fern and green and white hosta leaves. A twig umbrella stood alongside.

Finally, a trip to 'Carmen' set in Seville. For this, a bridge of glass tubes each containing different coloured gerbera represented the gypsy girls, while Carmen herself was a large dark rose. The 'Guardia' stood in command position. Julia told the story of how, during a fight, Carmen was stabbed – and Love-Lies- Bleeding flowed down. Maureen Parker


In aid of the 'Raise the Roof' fund

Attention all dog (and other) walkers – **Clophill has a new footpath!**

Clophill now has a new footpath. Well, not strictly new, since it has been an official right-of-way since at least 1964 when the Definitive Map (the official record of public rights-of-way) was produced. The path had been obstructed for many years by an earth bank, two fences and two hedges, and there have been few attempts to walk it. The path runs from Old Kiln Lane, opposite where the Greensand Ridge Walk emerges, northwards to a ditch where it meets a length of permissive path linking it to Bridleway 9, which is part of the through route from Clophill to Haynes.

After several years of attempts to have the obstructions removed, Central Beds has now cleared the obstructions, constructed steps up the bank and installed three new gates. Opening up the path has created a new circular route for walkers who can return to the village via Bridleway 9 or carry on along the permissive path towards Great Lane and on to the footpath which comes out by the Old Church.

If you like a walk in the countryside or need to exercise your dog, please make use of this path. The more people use it the more evidence there will be to resist any future attempts to close it. Don't forget to keep your dog on a lead if it's likely to run loose or to worry livestock. *Michael Brooks*

Notes from the Annual Parish Council meeting held on 29th September 2015

Readers are reminded that this is a resume only of the meeting. The parish council minutes are published and can be found on the internet after they are authorised (approximately five weeks after the relevant meeting).

Litter Problem

The appearance of our lovely village – and our parishioners' enjoyment of it – is under threat from the awful litter we're seeing around Clophill. Despite waste bins at The Green, the area is often covered in disposable packaging and bottles. Meanwhile, at the Rec new litter seems to appear every day. On top of this, the play equipment has recently been adorned with fresh graffiti. We're concerned that unless things change we'll never achieve the clean, picturesque social areas that we all desire.

This is all happening as a new national campaign 'Clean for The Queen' is being launched by Country Life magazine in partnership with 'Keep Britain Tidy' to clear up Britain in time for The Queen's 90th birthday in 2016. Whether or not we get involved in the campaign is another issue, but the message behind it is important – it's up to all of us. If you know of a litterer, ask them to use the bins provided instead.

Broadband in Clophill

A local debate has begun on the state of Clophill's 'broadband' internet, with Central Bedfordshire Councillor (and also Clophill Parish Councillor) Paul Downing keen to find out the views of villagers and their on-line/off-line experiences. Feedback so far has included views such as:

- 'Mine keeps dropping out and I've had numerous conversations with BT over the last 6 months in an attempt to get it sorted.'
- 'I had an ongoing problem for six weeks when the broadband kept dropping out completely – couldn't open a web page at all.'
- 'It's been really slow for ages.'

Clophill Parish Council is looking into what it can do to communicate with broadband providers, and will feedback through meetings and 'Spotlight'.

We're pleased to report that, after some residents told us they were worried about the safety of their youngsters, new fencing has been added by the Green. We'd also like to thank the kind people of Ampthill Building Company who recently made some repairs to our bus shelter without charge.

CB/15/03021/FULL

Location: Warren Farm, Warren Lane, Clophill

Proposal: To change use for an all-weather arena for equestrian use and the siting of a static caravan. The Parish Council has a number of concerns over this application. There seems to be an error with the address and CBC has been asked for clarification. Questions have also been raised concerning the siting of a large mobile home – whilst the application isn't for dwelling status it's stated that the van will be used on a 24/7 basis. Of special concern is the drainage from the site, highway access and the flood lighting of this naturally dark area of the village. Near neighbours have also made representation. **OBJECT**

CB/15/03035/FULL

Location: 8 The Causeway

Proposal: Application for single-storey rear extension with first-floor terrace and two-storey front extension. The Parish Council notes the very different modern design intended with this application. There are, however, two small points that it would like the planners to consider to preserve the privacy of near neighbours: firstly, the use of opaque glass in windows overlooking the neighbours on either side; secondly, extending the wall at first-floor level to the north side of the first -floor terrace to stop the small rear garden of the next door neighbours being overlooked.

CB/15/03062/FULL

Location: In the grounds of Hard Earnt, Kiln Lane

Proposal: Application for a dwelling. The intended building would measure some 60 feet in length on prominent ground overlooking the village. This is outside the village settlement area. Previous similar applications for near sites to this have been refused by planners. **OBJECT**

CB/15/02687/FULL

Location: 126A The High Street

Proposal: Last year a design was submitted to greatly increase the size of this property. Despite the objections of the Parish Council this was agreed by planners. This design is more thoughtful and will allow the new intended building to blend much better with the street scene and location. Near neighbours are supportive. **SUPPORT**

CB/15/02482/FULL

Location: Paradise Farm, The Causeway

Proposal: This is an amendment of the previously submitted application, but this time includes the retention of replacement barns. This doesn't alter the stance of the Parish
