The Old Church and Eco lodges – recreational activities

Over the summer we remained busy with guided 'Tower Tours' of The Old Church and newly introduced day-long recreational courses at the Lodges. Paula de Santis Smith, an artist/art teacher who lives in the village, ran a Saturday course in Water Colour Painting followed a week later by a Giant Bug's workshop for youngsters. Andy Fox ran two daylong 'Birds of Prey Photography' workshops and Sam Turner ran a kids yoga class.

Building works

In June, work was completed on our connection to the National Grid so we now have power and lighting as well as our security systems in place for both the Old Church and Lodges.

Work on commissioning the water bore hole and ground source heat pumps is in hand and we're also particularly grateful to the efforts made by volunteers in connection with the installation of underfloor heating and laminate floor covering in the warden's accommodation.

Funding, largely via the Green Infrastructure Plan, has enabled us to continue with getting the lodges ready for full occupation. Two of the lodges now have functioning hot water showers.

Clophill Preschool News



Hi everyone, we hope you've all enjoyed the summer break. We're very excited to be starting our third year at Clophill Preschool with over 30 children on our register and six brilliant members of staff. We've increased our opening hours this year and would like to thank the Village Hall for allowing us to do so.

At the end of last term we opened **a breakfast club**, and it's been a great success. We offer the children cereal, fruit or something toasted when they first come in then a snack around 10.45am. Some children may not have eaten before they come to us, others may have had an early start and need refuelling! We find a full tummy makes for better behaviour and better concentration – in grown-ups too!

Last term we applied for some funding for new equipment and over the summer holidays we received the good news that we'd been successful. So far we've purchased a new picket fence for our outside area and two more storage trolleys, one for construction equipment and tools and the other for water and sand toys.

We're always self-evaluating our setting and developing the areas to excite and stimulate the children. At the end of last term we made the mark-making and creative area more structured and created a larger drawing space. In our role play area we added **a karaoke machine** with a microphone and a mirror next to it. It's quite amazing to see the quietest of children pick up the mic and sing along to their favourite track. Some love an audience, others tend to face away from everyone, lost in their own little world. The language development and confidence building this engenders is fantastic. To develop this area further we've bought a tepee and a shop so we're looking forward to lots of counting and money work as well as the development of narratives and storytelling.

Don't forget to look out for our Scarecrow at this year's festival. It will be our first job when our doors open on September 7th! A busy term, as usual, with all the festivals to explore and celebrate, and we look forward to getting to know our new families as well as catching up with our current ones.

The demonstrator for our July meeting was Grania Newton, an experienced florist who's now venturing into demonstrating. Her theme was **'Yeats Country'**.

W B Yeats spent his childhood years in County Sligo, so Grania based her first design on the poem **'The Lake Isle of Innisfree'** (Innisfree means Heather Island). It was a modern arrangement using lilaccoloured roses, pink gerberas and aubergine and white carnations. Yeats was fascinated with Irish legends and folklore, which inspired Grania's next arrangement depicting the mythical Iron Age Queen Maeve. She filled a large metal vase with different forms and textures of plant material along with green anastasia chrysanthemums, red

gerberas, stocks and pink peonies.

Grania used fern to represent Glencar Waterfall, as mentioned in Yeats' poem **'The Stolen Child'**. Variegated persian ivy, clematis tendrils and gypsophila depicted the flow, and veronica, lisianthus and peonies – all white – were added for impact.

Mullaghmore is one of the best big-wave surfing locations in the world, with waves reaching up to 50ft high. A large curve to depict the giant wave had been made out of dried birch into which soft ruscus was incorporated. To create the effect of the sea breaking on the rocks Grania placed


white avalanche roses into her arrangement before using orange gerberas to represent the surfers.

Drumcliffe Round Tower is one of 52 Irish early Medieval stone towers which it's believed were built as bell towers or as a place of refuge.

Phormium tenax leaves were used for height and woven and intertwined palm leaves for added interest and depth. A striking spray of yellow cymbidium orchids completed the design.

The stunning sunsets off the coast of County Sligo were the inspiration for Grania's final arrangement, a horizontal design executed on the top of a very narrow round glass container. Pheasant berry was used for structure and cordyline, orange gerberas, rose espana and dried aspidistra leaves provided the rich colours of the sunset. *Ann Dowding*

Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe Rigatoni Pasta with Tuna Sauce



INGREDIENTS Serves 4

- 400g rigatoni rasta (or other short pasta)
- 3-4 cloves of garlic, peeled
- 1 bottle tomato passata
- whole branch of fresh sage leaves
- large tin of tuna in olive oil
- 1/2 tsp dried chilli flakes
- splash of extra virgin olive oil
- salt & freshly ground black pepper
- **1.** Bring to the boil a large pan of salted water.
- 2. Open the tin of tuna and drain the oil into a medium-sized pan.
- **3.** Add to this oil the peeled whole cloves of garlic, the chilli flakes and the sage and fry gently over a medium heat until the garlic becomes golden.
- **4.** Add in the tomato passata rinse out the jar with a little cold water and add to the pan.
- 5. Season to taste and simmer while your pasta is cooking.
- 6. Once the water is boiling add in the pasta and cook for 8-10 minutes or as directed on the packet.
- 7. When the pasta is half cooked add the flaked tuna to the sauce.
- 8. When the pasta is cooked drain thoroughly and add to the sauce.
- 9. Mix well and serve immediately.

Notes from the Parish Council meetings

Since the last edition of Spotlight there have been two parish council meetings.

- The council decided to **co-opt two additional council members** (with no voting rights): Sarah Chatwin and Steve Rodell.
- A resolution has been agreed, subject to conditions, for a grant of **£2k towards the Methodist Church roof repair**.
- The council discussed the **neighbourhood plan**, and heard from Tom Wakeman, who's been processing the data.
- We discussed the best course of action regarding the **safety of the High Street around the school** during school drop-off/pick-up times. No decisions have yet been made, but a clear course of action should be apparent by our September meeting.
- Also discussed at the meeting was how the council can better receive views and opinions from **young people** locally.

SUPPORTING CLOPHILL'S YOUNG PEOPLE

Over the school summer break, Clophill Parish Council spent time thinking about ways in which we can support the young people in our village, particularly those approaching or at school-leaving time. We asked ourselves how we can provide them with engaging, fulfilling activities and also ensure their opinions are heard as we make decisions about our future.

Recently, there have been lots of changes in Government policy for young people, including reforming of A level qualifications and the introduction of new traineeships to help young people prepare for apprenticeships. Then we have speculation about the reduction of tax credits and housing benefits for under-22s and the scrapping of university maintenance grants from 2016. In August, youth unemployment in the UK rose to 16%. On a national level, with so much changing so regularly, this is an uncertain time for young people. We feel it would benefit the entire village if we address this issue head on.

Previously the parish council has supported developments such as the local football team, the skate park in the recreation ground, a boxing class in the village hall and a litter pick in association with the Lower School. Yet we're aware that more can and should be done.

One obvious issue is that Clophill parish councillors, perhaps unfortunately, aren't teenagers and don't necessarily know what the right answers are. This is where we need your help. We'd like to hear from young people and their parents about their views on what is to be a teenager in Clophill. We'd be particularly interested in responses to these questions:

- What did you enjoy/dislike about the summer break?
- What would make Clophill a better place to grow up in?
- Would a 'Clophill Parish Youth Council' be something you'd be interested in taking part in?

Proposal: Change of use from a barn to a dwelling. The Parish Council understands that there has been a change in the legislation to allow for change of use in such circumstances. The Parish Council has requested that planners ensure that the current height and building footprint aren't exceeded so that this will ensure that the dwelling nestles into this countryside setting, if approved.
