Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

June is a wonderful time in the garden, as we transition from spring into summer. By now the hedgerows and gardens around the village are bursting into growth, with splashes of colour from a whole array of shrubs and flowers. But it's still possible for the odd cold night to strike so keep a piece of fleece to hand to protect your more tender summer plants, especially those recent purchases from garden centres.

Warm, wet weather means rapid lawn growth but some simple maintenance can **keep your lawn healthy over the season**. Lawns in full sun may need cutting twice a week, but take care not to cut the grass with blades set too low. In dry weather this can lead to bare patches, increased weeds and shallow rooted grass, which is more prone to drought.

If you want good grass on our sandy soil you'll need to use an appropriate summer lawn feed once a month. Only **apply fertiliser onto moist soil and evenly distribute it** to avoid scorching the grass. Good, established lawns may go dry and brown during dry periods, but soon green up when it rains. You can help water and air to penetrate by spiking compacted and dry lawns with a garden fork and wiggling it back and forth to loosen the soil and allow air and water to reach the roots.

Warm, wet weather also encourages your **herbaceous perennials** to shoot up, so they'll need supporting. The simplest way is to put a cane or stick firmly into the ground, at the rear of the plant, and tie around a loop of string. Think loose support with natural movement rather than rigidly upright. Plants that would benefit from support include delphiniums, climbing roses, oriental poppies and the tall varieties of catmint (nepeta).

June is also a good time to cut back and divide any of the earlier **flowing perennials** such as pulmonaria, aubrieta and

primulas. Lift clumps of plants, pull them apart and trim the old foliage, leaving about 5cm on each new plant. Add some compost into the soil and then replant, watering in well. This is also the time to prune down any spring flowering shrubs and deadhead spring flowering bulbs. Remember to water all newly planted trees, shrubs and flowering plants during dry weather until they've established good roots growth.

Deadheading will now become a key task as flowers finish and start to go over and lose their petals. With many plants the flowering period can be extended by removing the old flowers as soon as they fade. This stops the plant putting energy into producing seeds and instead channels it into new growth and flowers later in the summer and sometimes into autumn. Most deadheading can be done with secateurs, cutting back to just above strong buds lower down the stems of the plant. Some plants, like the hardy geraniums, can be trimmed back with garden shears. It looks drastic but the plant guickly puts on new growth and plants are kept nice and bushy.

And of course don't forget to **keep on top of weeding** while they're small – don't let them flower and set seeds!

Hello everyone. What beautiful weather we've been having and a wonderful way to celebrate Outdoor Classroom Day last month. We invited parents up for a Coffee Morning to give them the chance to see the newly developed outdoor area and how the children play and learn within it. We had a fantastic response from our parents, some even posting their comments on our Facebook page about how

great they think the area is. We ourselves can't quite believe the changes we've made to the space. We'd like to thank the Parish Council for their grant donation, which allowed us to accumulate the funds to pay for the new fence, to the Village Hall Committee for their unwavering support, and to our parents for helping with our fundraising events.

Where our children were once playing on a flat square piece of grass and patio we've now created an exciting and interesting space with hills and trees, **wooden walkways**, wood chip mounds, a pallet stage and a digging pit. Our children will find interest and ways to explore and develop play from the natural environment in a way they aren't able to when surrounded by the usual toys or resources.

Our children have been **hunting for minibeasts**, digging in the mud pit and using lengths of bark as funnels to run water from the water butt. They've been eating radishes that we've grown in the allotment and everyone is keeping an eye on the other fruit and vegetables – especially the strawberries!



Everyone has enjoyed travelling along the new wooden trail and over **the log stepping stones**. They've been scrambling up the muddy bank and sliding down the wooden slide, balancing as they walk across the top of the wall, running down the slope and making

their way along the secret path hidden behind the hill.



We're very lucky to have Sue, from The Clophill Centre, coming this term to create a willow tunnel for us. And in Dad's week – when we invite all dads, grandads, uncles etc – we hope to get them to work with the children **planting up herbs** in some of the tyres and helping to create some more climbing structures on the muddy bank. We also hope they can help make a chip and tyre hill for the children to climb over.

We feel incredibly proud of the fantastic space we're developing that allows for balancing, sliding, rolling, crawling and climbing. We're

providing a space that's flexible enough to ensure challenge for the most timid and the most adventurous, offering unpredictability and a sense of risk with little possibility of harm. While we continue to develop the space, we continue to fundraise. Clophill & District Flower Club

Last month we welcomed National Demonstrator Patricia Dibben for her demonstration 'Stepping Forward – Glancing Back'.

With the hall filled with over 70 members as well as a number of visitors, Patricia began with a large open-weave basket from Holland which she filled with foliage. As she worked, Patricia explained that it's important to manipulate not mutilate when trimming it to size, before adding Solidago, green Dianthus, Sweet William and tulips.

Patricia's second arrangement involved two placements enclosed in a metal frame and it included red Anthurium, purple Lilac and an old-fashioned light pink rose. Next a raised container was filled with palms, Bergenia leaves and Hebe to which Patricia added orange orchid, Solidago and red Anthuriums. To complete the design, she included a similar smaller arrangement at table level.

Now 'glancing back', the next design recalled the WAFAS 2017 show in Barbados. Patricia used a beautiful piece of wood along with ferns, Aspidistra, variegated Fatsia and Cordyline, and a Caribbean splash of colour was created with Heleconium, Ginger Lilies and large orange gerbera. When completed, Patricia added a second similar design to produce a stunning display. Once again looking back to years ago when Patricia started work as a florist she explained that designs were quite often triangular – and so her fifth design reflected this. It was all white, arranged in an elevated white urn with Larkspur, Delphinium, lilies and Avalanche roses to which she added a smaller arrangement at the base.

Patricia told us how she joined the first full-time floristry course in the country which was held in Tottenham and as time went on she decided she wanted to learn more contemporary skills. Her sixth and final design was a more 'stepping forward' contemporary design. Two red circles suspended in a frame were decorated as sunsets with green foliage, yellow Solidago, orange gerbera and bright red Anthurium and dark red roses. Once again, the design was completed with a third placement. Many members and visitors went home happy with their raffle prize designs.

We are a very active club with nearly 90 members. During the year there are monthly demonstrations – twice a year with National Demonstrators, a social practical evening and sessions of flower arranging for beginners and the more able. Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

Rigatoni Pasta with Broad Beans and Ham



INGREDIENTS Serves 6

- 500g rigatoni pasta
- 1½ tbsp extra virgin olive oil
- 1 medium onion

• 1 stick of fresh celery

- 3-4 slices of pancetta or streaky bacon
- 400g shelled fresh broad beans
- 100g cooked ham (remove any fat)
- freshly grated Parmesan cheese
- 1. Put a large pan of salted water on to boil. 2. Heat the oil on a medium heat
- and add in the finely chopped onion, celery and pancetta. Cook until softened but not browned.
- 3. Meanwhile cook the beans in boiling salted water for about 10 minutes (use the same water that you will cook the pasta in) then remove with a slotted spoon.
- **4.** Add the beans to the onion mixture.
- **5.** Cook the pasta according to the packet directions to avoid over cooking.
- **6.** Whilst the pasta is cooking cut the cooked ham into thin strips and add to the onion mixture.
- **7.** Season to taste.
- **8.** Drain the pasta and add to the bean mixture.
- **10.** Sprinkle with the grated Parmesan cheese.

9. Mix well and turn out into a heated dish. Christine runs Italian cookery classes at Casa Fellini in Clophill

Messy Church says 'We're all messy, our lives aren't perfect, our families and children aren't perfect and we believe the best space for God to deal with us in our messiness and disorder is in church. Come and join us.'



Clophill holds its very own Messy Church once a month at the Methodist Church between 4pm and 6pm. At a typical session, you'll be welcomed at the door and given a name sticker then off you go to choose a craft or activity. There are usually about six different things to do – and despite trying to hold themselves back, the adults can't resist getting stuck in.

At around 5pm we come together for a short period of worship, led by our minister, Graham Claydon-Knights.

We sing, bash instruments, listen to stories and show everyone what we have made. It's usually very noisy and chaotic, but totally fun and inclusive. Afterwards we all share tea, which could be anything from hotdogs to pasta, with plenty of cakes for dessert. Then everyone usually helps to tidy up and the kids go home tired (yay!).

Messy Church is for all ages – our current members range from 2 to 80+. There's no fixed fee, we only ask for a donation to cover costs.

Anglia Water update

Lots of residents are asking us for updates about Anglian Water's water main works. Our website 'noticeboard' section has full details, with all dates for quidance only.

By the time you receive this month's Spotlight it's anticipated that Phase 5 (High Street, Cainhoe Road to The Green) will have been completed. The final phase (6) at the Green is due to start 11th June. This will initially be as a one-way system around the Green, much like a roundabout, until the 29th June. This will allow traffic to continue in and out of Clophill.

The final connection in the A6 junction will need to be a hard road closure and Anglian Water anticipate this starting on 30th June and running until 13th July, with weekend working. Traffic will be able to enter the village but not able to leave via the A6.

The final cut and caps of the old main will take place from 13th to 19th July in Cainhoe Road/Goodhall Crescent junction and High Street/Great Lane junction.

Lakes site

We were asked by a member of the public if we could update the village with regard to the Lakes site. The latest news is that Gallagher Estates (GE), who own the site, have recently put different members of staff to oversee the area their end and are still getting up to speed with their role. Central Bedfordshire Council and GE are still in discussions about terms for Section 106 (a legal agreement between an applicant seeking planning permission and the local planning authority, which is used to mitigate the impact of new homes on the local community and infrastructure). We're still engaged in the process, and will keep the village informed of any future developments.

Clophill clean-up

A HUGE thank you to the 50+ volunteers for helping out with the Clophill Clean Up last month. We were delighted by your response. Pictures of volunteers in action can be found on our Facebook page. We'd also like to thank Nell Lee for her help in coordinating the Clean Up this year. We politely request that, where possible, villagers put their litter in bins provided or take it home with them.
