#### Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

As we move into summer and hope for long, hot days it can be challenging to keep the garden looking in tip-top condition. Visitors

to my garden often comment on how colourful and lush it looks, while theirs are starting to look dry and crispy. This got me thinking about some of the challenges we face in Clophill, with our low rainfall and sandy, free-draining soils – so this month I'm going to concentrate on plants that will cope well with dry shady spaces.

Most gardens have some dry shade; at the foot of walls, where foundations draw water from the soil, or under eaves, where little rain falls. Trees and hedges also create dry shade, as their roots take up a lot of water. As a rule, shade-lovers with large leaves, such

as hostas, are best avoided when planting in dry shade, as such lush foliage requires a continually moist soil.

If impact is what you're looking for, then **one of the most dramatic shrubs for shade is Fatsia japonica** (aka False Caster Oil plant). This exotic-leaved evergreen is completely hardy outdoors and will eventually make a magnificent plant. The variegated variety, aptly named 'spiders web' has white edging to the leaves along with white splashes on its dark green leaves.

### Plant a foliage backbone of ivies and hardy ferns, adding spring-flowering periwinkles and epimediums

for their leaves and flowers. These will give you a green tapestry into which you can plant snowdrops and shorter narcissi for spring. The most handsome ferns for dry conditions are conveniently called dryopteris and these upright ferns will, in time, make bold statements. Other excellent ferns for dry shade include the harts tongue fern, Polypodiums and shield ferns. Adding in some Coleus plants with **their two-tone leaves in shades of red, white, purple and green** can look absolutely amazing especially when planted in drifts.

If you're looking for easy flowers to add to these areas then two most useful seeds are those of aquilegia and honesty (Lunaria annua), which can be sprinkled directly onto the soil, lightly raked in and left to germinate. Do this over the summer and next year you should be rewarded with a swathe of colour. Where possible, go for white or light coloured flowers as darker colours don't show up so well in shade.

Finally, try some **early-flowering**, **hardy geraniums**, principally forms of Geranium phaeum and G. macrorrhizum. Again, go for paler forms that light up shade like; G. phaeum 'Alba' and the soft apple-blossom pink G.macrorrhizum 'Ingwersen's Variety'. I'd also try to introduce Bowles' Golden Grass (Mileum effusum 'Aureum'). It has perennial golden leaves and also self seeds well and should pop up to lighten the darkness.

When buying plants always opt for smaller, younger plants grown in a loam-based compost. They will be easier to establish and often grow away quicker than if you invest in a larger, more mature plant. And remember that all new plants will need regular watering during dry periods to enable them to grow lots of new roots to withstand the dry conditions.

#### Hello everyone

We had some dad's, grandads and uncles up in Dad's Week and beyond, helping us to put up the new fence covering and planting tyres with herbs. Dad Paul Summer came up with fossils embedded in clay for the children to crack open with stones and investigate what they found. We definitely have some **mini palaeontologists** in our midst!

As we look towards the end of this very successful year we're transitioning our children to six different schools. We'll be sad to see them go but hope that our thorough and supportive transition process ensures their transition is as smooth and positive as possible. The process includes a weekly School

Readiness Group, photo books and uniform for children to share with their friends, Forest School sessions with Nell from Salix Education and ensuring all schools visit our setting. Before our children go we have Sports Day, our Leavers Picnic and the end of term trip.

#### Christine's quick 'n' easy recipe

### Courgette Salad with Chicken, Pine Nuts & Pesto

- 1. Slice the washed courgettes lengthways using a potato peeler, discard the first slice which is just skin.
- **2.** Use leftover chicken or store-bought rotisserie chicken. Shred into small pieces.
- 3. Put the courgette slices and chicken into a bowl large enough to mix together.
- **4.** Season to taste and mix well.
- **5.** Add in the pine nuts and pesto and mix well again.

#### Annual Report May 2018

#### Summary of 2017-2018

The year ending May 2018 has been another good year for the Village Hall.



The Committee can report an excellent year in terms of its financial performance. We've continued with our policy of controlling costs tightly and maintaining high occupancy levels at the hall to drive revenue. This has resulted in the Village Hall pretty much breaking even, whilst still maintaining very competitive rates for users and continued investment in the maintenance of the hall. As a result of this strong financial performance we've been able to reinvest in the hall to maintain and upgrade our offering to users.

- We've purchased a new cooker, which was much needed.
- We've recently purchased an industrial floor-cleaning machine to improve the cleanliness and presentation of the floor.
- The hall has received a much needed 'deep clean' and going forward we intend to make this a routine process two or three times a year.

We will continue to invest wisely to maintain and continually improve our standards.

Just before Christmas 2017 we conducted our customary fundraiser – the Santa Sleigh – which was really well received by the families in the village. In May 2018 we also welcomed back the Ska band Hope & Glory, who went down a storm, playing to almost 100 attendees. Special thanks to our bar provider, Sarah, who donated her payment for the night to Village Hall funds. The event raised nearly £600, which has gone a long way to paying for our newly purchased floor cleaner.

As indicated above we've managed to run the hall again on a break-even basis for the year, but we're constantly trying to manage our expenditure to ensure user charges remain reasonable whilst offering users a good experience. The consequence of this is that, except for a cleaner, we have no paid staff, unlike several village halls in the area who employ a paid manager. Whilst this would be a great asset to the hall, the costs would have to be reflected in higher hiring charges.

We currently don't want to go down this path, but it means our users must take some collective responsibility in maintaining the cleanliness and security of the hall. Sadly this isn't always the case and we've had examples of unacceptable levels of cleanliness, doors being left open when users leave and the cooker left on. This isn't our village hall, but belongs to he community, so we appeal to all users to respect their facility and adopt sensible behaviour for the benefit of all of the community.

The burden of these issues falls most often on the shoulders of our small committee so a very special thank you to all members of the Village Hall Management Committee for their hard work and personal time devoted to the upkeep and running of the hall. With just eight members, we would very much welcome some new members to spread the load and maybe bring some new ideas. If you're interested just call me on *07831 255807*.

- continue to manage our costs and revenues.
- maintain the quality of the fabric of the hall at least cost but presenting the highest possible standards for users.
- expanding the Village Hall Management Committee membership.

### Remembering Clophill's Fallen

Continuing our series of the centenary of Clophill's brave men who lost their lives in the First World war...

In July the family and friends of Sydney William Young learned that he'd been killed in action on 19th July 1918, aged 27. In August there came the news that Ernest George Diggins, also 27, had suffered the same fate on the 23rd. For the Diggins family this must have been a particularly bitter blow as they'd already lost their son, Henry, in November 1916. Their third son, Owen, also served but survived the war.

**Sydney Young** was born in Clophill in 1891. At the time of his death his parents, George, a butcher, and Elizabeth, lived at Ketton Cottage, now 41 High Street. In 1911 they lived in The Strand. Sydney didn't live with them at this time.

Sydney served as a Lance Corporal in the 2nd Regiment in the South African Infantry. The Union of South Africa entered the war in August 1914 in support of Great Britain. The 2nd regiment was formed from the Natal area.

Ampthill News reported in August 1918:-

'Universal sympathy prevailed on Monday for Mr. & Mrs. G Young and family, in the loss

of their son, Sydney. He had seen much active service. He joined the South African Forces early, and was in German East Africa for 18 months. He had several attacks of malaria, and was discharged. On his recovery he volunteered again for service in France. He came to England for training, and then went to France. He was killed on July 19th. A letter from the officer of his Company states that in an advance the whole of his section was killed.'

Sydney is Commemorated In Meteren Cemetery, Nord, France – the scene of his last battle.

**Ernest George Diggins** was born in Clophill in 1891. In 1911 Ernest worked as a farm labourer and lived in Hall End, Maulden, with his parents Mary and Charles and six of his siblings. Charles, who'd been a police constable in London, was at this time 'a police pensioner', aged 55. Previously the family had lived on the High Street, Clophill.

Ernest volunteered in November 1915, and served with the 1st Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment. The following July he was sent to the Western Front and was involved in battles at Arras, Ypres, Cambrai and Nouvechappelle.

In April 1918, in response to the German Spring Offensives, the 1st battalion were rushed back to the Western Front and fought in the Battle of Hazebrouck. Once the Allied army went on the final push that would become known as the '100 Days Offensive' they were engaged in several

actions including in the Battle of Albert in August. Ernest was killed in Achiet-Le-Petit.

Ernest is commemorated in Adanac Military Cemetery, Miraumont Somme, France.

#### **Anglian Water Update**

We're nearly at the end of Anglian Water's (AW) water main works in the village. In order to complete the work, this month will see planned road closures, which will restrict vehicles leaving the village via the A6 but not vehicles entering the village. Our website 'noticeboard' section has full details – all dates are for guidance only – with the planned closures as follows:-

Weekend 1: 7-8 July Weekend 2: 14-15 July

Weekend 3: 21-22 July (if this doesn"t take place then we will skip to weekend 4)

Weekend 4: 28-29 July

A temporary bus stop for the northbound bus will be in place on the A6 just north of Maulden Road. Notices will be on display at the existing bus stops to pre-warn passengers.

#### **Lakes Site**

With regard to the Lakes site on the east side of the village, there has been very little development in the last month. Central Bedfordshire Council (CBC) and Gallagher Estates (GE) are still in discussions about terms for Section 106 (a legal agreement between an applicant seeking planning permission and the local planning authority, which is used to mitigate the impact of new homes on the local community and infrastructure). We continue to be engaged in the process, and will keep the village informed of any future developments.
