We've been so lucky with the weather and our children have been thoroughly enjoying the outdoors and exploring nature in the autumn. We've swept leaves, thrown leaves, sculpted with leaves, hidden in leaves and – our favourite – jumped in leaves.


Our outdoor space is improving yet again as we were granted funding by Parish Council to further develop it. Our once muddy patch outside the back doors is now neatly paved over, giving us a great space for water play and room to sit down and swap into wellies. Our slippery slope leading up to the shed has been covered in more of our second-hand artificial turf with a tyre wall between, making **a great climbing space**. The wooden

gates have been straightened and we're just waiting for the fitting of new metal gates to the rear entrance to Preschool. A huge thank you to the Parish Council for making this possible, to the Village Hall Committee for all your support and once again to Gary and Jake and the boys for going above and beyond.

As ever, we've been working hard to raise funds on our side with events like our first ever Christmas Market, which went really well. That and our Happy Bags collection alone

raised over £800. Our next event is the **Family Christmas Craft Morning** on Friday 21st December, 10am-noon.

Last month our children learnt about **Armistice Day** and as we painted poppies made from plastic bottles we talked about why we commemorate the day. We fixed the poppies to a slice of tree trunk and attached some chestnut leaves, then took our homemade wreath to the Remembrance service at St. Mary's Church, where it was laid on the war memorial. Also in November we were delighted to receive Silas, the Minister from the Methodist Church, for the first time and we're really looking forward to him becoming a regular visitor. Rosemary, from St Mary's Church, also came up to do our traditional Christingle with the children.



Our children have been busy practising the Nativity, another one rewritten by us, and we're looking forward to performing 'We're Going on a Baby Hunt' before the end of term. We've been making natural tree decorations for **The Tree Dressing Challenge**, organised by Common Ground, to highlight the importance of trees in our environment, and made our own Christmas tree from cable reels for the Methodist Christmas Tree Festival.

On our last day this year we're having a Christmas party and will be serving hot Christmas dinners to the children. So, on that note, may we take the opportunity to wish you all a very happy and safe Christmas and hope to see many of you at our family Craft Morning on the 21st.

Clophill Remembers

There was standing room only in the church on Remembrance Sunday to mark the 100th anniversary of the Armistice in 1918. Nearly 250 people were counted in for the service at which Colonel Tony Winton, Deputy Lord Lieutenant of Bedfordshire, was Guest of Honour. Flags were presented by The Royal British Legion, The Brownies and Flitvale Scouts. Children from St. Mary's

School sang and did a presentation on three Clophill men who died in the First World War. Many more people joined us for the Act of Remembrance at the War Memorial, where 20 wreaths were laid and the children planted wooden crosses for each of the men who gave their lives in both world wars. The clock struck 11 as the Last Post was played.

Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

Winter is here – but despite the cold, some plants look even better at this time of year. Frost illuminates the ornamental grasses and stems of the shrubs and trees – and they look particularly stunning as they glow in the low winter sun.

For non-hardy plants, winter protection is needed if they are to survive and grace your garden next year. It's best to cover the plants under glass and raise the container – by inserting feet or raising it on bricks – so it's off the ground. If the pots are staying outside, wrap them with something insulating like bubble wrap, hessian or old jumpers. When it's very cold, **cover the plant with some horticultural fleece** – but remember to remove it when the cold spell ends to ensure the plant gets plenty of air circulation. Plants covered all winter, or covered up for too long, often get damp, rot off and die, so all your hard work to protect the roots will have been in vain.

While many of us struggled (and failed) to have a lush green lawn over the summer, winter can also cause its fair share of problems. When frozen, the grass blades become brittle, so snap and break when trodden on in frosty conditions. This will leave brown marks where the grass is damaged, which look unsightly in the spring and will make that patch more susceptible to disease. Given how hard it is to create a decent lawn

it's worth resisting walking on it during the very cold weather.

Now's the time to **prune woody plants** like acers, birch and vines, which will bleed if pruning is left into the new year. Vines can be pruned hard, back to two buds of last year's growth, to encourage fruiting spurs and, in the case of the ornamental Vitis coignetiae, larger foliage. Acer and birch need shaping carefully, as so much of their elegance is in the delicate



growth of the limbs. The key is to shape gently and regularly so that you never have to cut into old wood, feathering growth back to a limb further within the canopy.

Apples and pears, currants and **autumn-fruiting raspberries** can be pruned any time from leaf drop until March, but never prune stone fruit in the winter as the retreating sap can draw in the airborne fungus, silver-leaf.

It's also the perfect time to take hardwood cuttings. A pencil-sized piece of wood, cut straight below a bud at the bottom and above a bud at the top (on a slant to let the water run off), can be set into free-draining compost to half its length. Hardwood cuttings can be taken from many plants including willows, poplars & Cornus alba and make a cheap and reliable method of generating new plants. Willows are so easy that they can be plunged into the ground as whole branches, but the best results are always when the sap is still in the wood, so this side of Christmas is your goal.

Our members and visitors enjoyed a fabulous evening last month when Lee Berrill, from Northamptonshire, gave us a light-hearted look at Christmas with his 'All that glitters' demonstration.



Lee featured baubles in many of his arrangements and confessed that he uses so many each Christmas that, come January, he buys them in bulk in the sales ready for the coming year. One of his first arrangements of the evening used **a bauble that**

he'd made out of hula hoops and mesh fabric, into which he arranged red gerbera, anthuriums and carnations.

As he made his displays, Lee explained that his interest in flowers started when he had to accompany his mother to a demonstration because his father wasn't home in time to babysit. After leaving school he attended a City & Guilds College in Wales where he studied floristry, botany and other subjects, then worked at a florist in Luton. He now has his own business in Earls Barton.

As well as buying baubles in the sales. Lee advised that electrician's

cable ties are excellent for securing mechanics and said that having friends who have gardens with lots of foliage that he can cut are invaluable! His dog walking neighbour collects pine cones for him – he used over 400 in his next arrangement of yellow chrysanthemums and roses.

Another design, **'Three Kings'**, was in rich purple and red carnations and gerbera with purple ostrich feathers.

More baubles came next with orange flowers, then a more traditional 'winter' arrangement featuring cones, white lisianthis and lilies with blue cedar sprays. Finally, 'Music' – three very colourful arrangements using holly, ivy and red and burgundy flowers, one on a drum, another around a violin and the final one with a harp. It was a spectacular end to a very special evening. *Kate Smith*
