We were delighted that so many of our parents turned up for the children to dance with Katie from Silsoe Dance, and they all did us proud. Our eco paper pot making and planting was very busy, it was great to see our children and their families as well as meeting new ones. It was also lovely to meet Elaine, the

new Spotlight editor, who was kind enough to pop to our stall and introduce herself, a great chance to put a face to the name!

Our next event is the Happy School Bags clothing collection on Monday 10th June, if you're doing a sort out of clothes, shoes or bedding, we would welcome your donation. This day is also the start of our Dad's week when we invite dads, grandads, brothers and uncles into preschool. The focus will be on constructing a new floor level sand pit and creating some more planting areas. It's great getting dads to share precious time in the setting with their children, who get to show them what they like to do, and the friends they like to play with; it can be quite a special time. The willow we planted along the tunnel is growing beautifully, the children have been watering them when they can. The allotment is looking abundant with carrots, onions, strawberries, courgettes,



tomatoes, peas and potatoes. Our lovely parents have provided many of the plants and we have been offered some squash plants too. We should be able to harvest much of this for our summer snack times soon.



The children have been very creative again this term doing large scale painting and making models from junk. We have boxes available all the time for children to use and create something from their interests. They use masking tape to stick boxes together thinking critically and creatively about how to represent their ideas. The deep engagement the children have while playing offer fantastic opportunities for us to teach them, to take their learning and interests to a greater level.

As our older children move through their last summer term with us, we are ensuring we work with them to build on their resilience and confidence. We are working with parents so that they can support their children, and feel confident themselves about this next step in their children's lives. Our stick and rope swing is a great way for the children to work their bodies and minds as they learn how to move, taking turns and explaining to each other how to do it, as well as congratulating others on their attempts. This month we have welcomed several hundred new residents to the Eco Lodge site: Bees! **A swarm of bees** was safely collected locally and has been housed in one of



the empty Eco Lodge hives. So far, they seem content in their new home and it was fitting as 20th May was World Bee Day!

At this time of year, it is common to see a swarm of honey bees that will settle on trees, bushes, signs or sheds. If you should find a swarm please notify one of the Swarm Collectors from the Bedfordshire Beekeepers Association www.bedsbka. org.uk/swarm-collectors who will come and collect

the swarm into a travel hive, they will then be moved to a new home in a nearby vacant hive (for honey bees only). If you would like more information about any types of bee

or swarming they have lots on their website.

We are thrilled to announce another new resident; **our new On-Site Warden Louise**. She has moved into the Warden's Lodge with the gorgeous Reilly (see picture) and is already hard at work championing new menus for our café which include gluten & dairy free options.

Throughout the summer we will be running guided walks identifying medicinal, edible & interesting plants, and we are lucky to have resident expert Kate Gardner leading these. She has been hard at work trying out many different uses for plants, some obvious and some very surprising, and will have samples available for you to try at every walk. #### **Clophill & District Flower Club**

David Thomson was the demonstrator at our May open evening. His chosen title was 'Flora Mania'. David worked to a floral pallet, using one colour for each arrangement, pink, yellow, peach, cream, purple and finishing with an amazing African Sunset. The colours ranging from soft pale to dazzling bright dark, soft and dense textures.



A large willow basket was used for an arrangement in pink. Gerbera, Oriental Lilies, pink and white Moermon and Aqua Roses, together with Eucalyptus and various greenery. Tall bright yellow Sunflowers, Calla Lilies, Carnations and Roses, Goldheart Ivy, Fatsia Japonica leaves and Euonymus made a stunning display in a tall iron container.

A sphere made from woven wood contained terracotta Antirrhinums (snap dragons), Gerbera, Roses in shades of peach. Aspidistra leaves woven and curled into different shapes gave depth to the arrangement. A large bamboo urn covered



in mother of pearl buttons containing white Delphiniums, creamy white Arium Lilies, Honey Bush (blue grey leaf), Snowflake Gerbera, Avalanche Roses and Orchids. A creamy delight. Black Tia Leaves gave height to a mauve pot, Rosemary, Hebie, purple Alliums, Antirrhinums, Dancing Cloud Roses, Clematis and Vanda Orchids completed a purple design.

Last, we were shown the delights of an African Sunset. A three foot urn in brilliant yellow, black and brown held yellow Gladioli, Ginger Lilies, orange Gerbera, pink Anthuriam, orange and yellow tipped Helliconia and Gloriosa Orchids. Various greenery completed an amazing design.



Four designs had a twin making 10 arrangements for our raffle, the amazing design was won by our Vice Chairman. David's arrangements were beautiful, his chatter entertaining, we hope he will return soon.

## Shefford Craft & Produce Show Saturday 31st August 2019

We are looking forward to this year's Craft & Produce Show which will no doubt be with us before we know it. As usual, our 39th Show will be held in the rooms behind Shefford Methodist Church, opening to visitors at 2pm and with presentation of prizes at 4pm. It was lovely to see new faces amongst the adult and child entrants last year and we hope to see even more this year, you don't have to live in Shefford to enter.

There are numerous cups and shields for adults and children to win. If you enjoy being busy in the kitchen or garden, making things or arranging flowers, there is plenty of choice. Shefford and the surrounding villages are now bigger than ever and it would be lovely to see our entry numbers grow in a similar way. We frequently hear people who are looking at the entries say 'I could do that', so why not make this the year that you try. Depending on their age, children also have various opportunities to make things in or out of the kitchen, and all are able to submit a photograph. If a child is a member of one of the Guiding or Scouting groups, they are also eligible to enter the appropriate Uniformed Groups class.

The person gaining the most points in the Flowers & Plants classes will now be able to win The Marriott Cup. In this section (and new to the show) we have a class for one flower in a vase, as well as one vegetable. The Firework Committee Novice Tray is being used for one of the Garden Produce classes this year. We know that lots of you grow tomatoes and if you've never won first prize for them in a show, you are eligible to enter this class. Another new cup is the Royal British Legion Cup and each year it will be given to the person who gains the most points in the photography section. In recognition of this, one of the photo-graphs we are asking for is 'We Will Remember Them'. When at least one adult and one child from the same family enter, they are eligible for The Joyce Davies Family Cup, which is given to the family who gain the most points overall.

#### Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner



Welcome to June and to one of the busiest months in the Garden. Chelsea Flower Show,

with its inspiring garden designs, has been and gone and the nurseries and garden centres are brimming over with plants in all shapes and colours. As I write this, it's National Bee Day. This got me thinking about the 'June gap', which can cause a major problem for both our bumble and honey bees.

The 'June gap' is as strange phenomenon. The term refers to a period when there is a sudden reduction in the amount of pollen and nectar around to feed honeybees. This is a problem for bees because in May, the colonies of many bee species are growing rapidly. Honey bees will be reaching peak colony size and bumblebees will have their workers out in force.

During spring: in addition to many early flowering herbaceous plants there are vast volumes of pollen and nectar produced from trees and hedges, especially from the Hawthorn. In May the rapeseed flowers can bring a serious glut, but suddenly in June this can all be over and the grass is starting to suppress many of the wild flowers. By the middle of July many of the tall herbaceous plants start to flower and often go on then until September, but the challenge is what to do to bridge the gap.

This is where our gardens come into their own. With some careful plant choices it is possible to not only have a beautiful garden, but to also provide a food haven for our bees and other pollinators. Hebe, Choiysia, Pyracantha and Cotoneaster are all popular with bees and are good for providing shape and structure to our gardens. Ceonothus or Californian Lilac is one of my favourites with its flowers ranging from the palest blue to an incredible deep bluey purple. Right now, in my garden, the Nepeta, perennial Geraniums, Campanulas, Thymes, Sage, Valerian, Wallflowers and Osteospurmums are in bloom - attracting large numbers of bees. As June progresses, the lavender, Sweet Williams and blue Echinops thistles will add to the mix.

June 21st is the longest day of the year, and the extra light and warmth also means weeds will sprout up from seemingly nowhere. Keep on top of them by hoeing regularly in dry conditions and adding mulch around your plants. Not only will it help to keep the weeds down but all mulches will help to keep the soil moist and reduce the amount of watering.

Hanging Baskets and planters are starting to make an appearance too. Argyranthemum, Lysimachia (creeping jenny), Dichondra 'Silver Falls', Fuchsia, Pelargonium (geraniums), Lobelia, Viola (pansies), Petunia, Salvia and Nicotiana (tobacco plants) are great for adding colour while being good for bees too.

Hanging baskets rely the most on the gardener to ensure they don't dry out, so to ensure that your baskets look their best throughout the whole summer, make sure that you use enough water to keep the baskets moist (but not soggy) and give them a liquid fertiliser feed once a week.

Remember that any spare plants that you have can be donated to the plant stall at this years Open Gardens, so please do bring them along to the church on Saturday 22nd June.
