Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

This month I thought I would turn my attention to the various pests and diseases that we often encounter during the coming months. Every year the RHS compiles a list based on reports from around the country to monitor areas of concern.

Box Tree caterpillars top the list. These East Asian moths arrived in the UK during 2007 and by 2019 colonies of the moths have become well established. The caterpillars are greeny yellow with black heads and reach up to 4cm in length. The caterpillars eat box leaves and cover the areas they are eating with a fine web and can very quickly defoliate box plants. Where practical its best to

remove the caterpillars by hand as the webbing makes spraying with insecticides guite challenging.



Number 2 on the list is the **vine weevil**. Plants growing in pots and containers are the most likely to be attacked and damaged by the vine weevil grubs. These plump c shaped legless grubs with their light brown heads live in the

compost around the roots. They eat the roots of the plants causing your plants to suddenly wilt and die – when you lift them out they have no

roots. The adult beetles feed on the leaves of the plants at night and the presence of these irregular shaped notches are often the first indication that you have a problem. There is a biological control for the larvae which you can water into your pots during the summer.



Woolly Aphid is a common pest of pyracantha, cotoneaster and apple trees. This is a sap sucking aphid which causes lumpy swellings on the bark, and in the summer the colonies of aphids can be seen covered in a white waxy fluff which if often mistaken for mould. These swellings can split in the winter and create entry wounds for fungal diseases such as apple canker. Where you have a small infestation one of the best controls is to scrub colony with a stiff bristled brush. Its natural predators are ladybird, lacewing and hoverfly larvae and recent research as shown that earwigs will also reduce aphids and not damage the fruit trees. Providing flower pots lightly stuffed with hay or straw into affected trees can help increase your earwig colony.

Honey fungus is the common name given to several different fungi which attack and kill the roots of many woody and perennial plants. The honey fungus spreads underground and some of the typical symptoms that you may see are die back of the upper parts of the plant, premature autumn colour, cracking and bleeding of the bark at the base of the stem and clumps of honey coloured toadstools in the autumn.

Rose black spot is a fungal disease of roses which infects the leaves and greatly reduces the vigour of the plant. Typically, a rapidly enlarging black patch appears on the upper leaf surface, before the leaf turns yellow and drops off the plant. Badly affected plants can drop almost all their leaves and have fewer rose blooms. Collecting up all fallen leaves and putting them into your green waste bags will help reduce spore spread.

One disease that I do notice in Clophill is hollyhock rust. This is a fungus spread by airborne spores and is worse in wet summers. Affected plants will have bright yellow or orange spots on the upper surface of the leaves, with reddish orange lumpy spore producing pustules on the underside of the leaf. The disease affects the lower leaves and spreads up the plant and the worst affected leaves with shrivel and fall off the plant. Removing the affected leaves as they appear can reduce the impact on the plants.

Early intervention with these should help to reduce their impact on your gardens. *Happy Gardening*




join the Great British

Rhubarb Almond Cake with Orange

INGREDIENTS Preparation time: 25 mins Cooking time: 1 hour

- 150g unsalted butter, softened, plus extra for greasing
- 150g golden caster sugar (ordinary will do if no golden in your larder)
- 2 large eggs

- 200g ground almonds
- 115g plain flour, sifted

- 2 tsp baking powder
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- ½ orange zest
- 1 tbsp Grand Marnier, Cointreau or orange juice
- 350g rhubarb, cut into 2-3cm pieces
- 1 tbsp demerara sugar



- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C, gas mark 4, fan 160°C. Grease and line the base of a 20cm deep cake tin with a removable base. In a large bowl, beat the butter and caster sugar with electric beaters for a few minutes until light and fluffy. Add the eggs one at a time, beating thoroughly between each. Add the almonds, flour and baking powder, followed by the vanilla, orange zest and liqueur or juice, gently fold in.
- 2. Spoon ½ the batter into the prepared tin and cover with ½ the rhubarb. Spread the remaining batter on top and finish with the rest of the rhubarb, arranged in a pretty pattern if wished. Scatter over the demerara sugar.
- 3. Put the cake in the oven and immediately reduce the temperature to 170°C, gas mark 3, fan 150°C. Bake for about an hour until golden with a firm centre. Cover loosely with foil halfway through the cooking time if it is browning too much. Allow to cool in the tin. Serve sliced as a teatime cake or warmed as a pudding with ice cream, if liked.



Clophill's Serving Survivors of WW1

In celebration of Clophill's brave men who fought in and survived the First World war...

Owen Alexander Diggins enlisted in the 1st King's Shropshire Light Infantry in November 1914 in Oswestry. He stated that he was born in 1894 but he was actually born in 1895, in Clophill. In 1911 he lived in Hall End. He was a "Gardener Domestic, and later a chauffeur. He was promoted to Acting Lance Corporal in 1915 and Acting Corporal in 1916. Owen was made Acting Sergeant in 1917. At the end of 1917 he joined the Training Reserve Battalion and reverted to the rank of Private. He was drafted to the Western Front. in March 1918 and promoted to the substantive rank of Lance Corporal in May 1918 and Lance Sergeant in October '18. He took part in numerous engagements in the Retreat and Advance of 1918, including those near Arras, Ypres, the Marne and the Aisne. He joined the Army Reserve in March 1919 as a Lance Sergeant. On leaving military service he was described as "Military Character Good." He returned to Hall End. Owen married Amy Blagg, who was one of the first women to join the WRAF. He died in 1972, aged 76.

Frederick John (Jack) Durston was born in the Rising Sun, Clophill in 1893. His grandparents (The Garners) were the licensees. He continued to live at the pub when his father became the licensee.

Long Jack, as he was known worked as a Farm labourer in 1911. He was one of 8 children. He served with the Sportsmen's Battalion, playing as a Drummer in their band. He went to France in 1915, serving as a Corporal. Jack also became a Goalkeeper for the Royal Engineers and made 2 appearances for Clapton Orient during leave in 1917, playing against Chelsea on both occasions. He also played for Queens Park Rangers, Brentford, Northfleet and Bedford Town.

Jack married Lily Hill in 1916 and had 2 children. He became a first-class cricketer, playing for Middlesex and England, and is a member of the Middlesex Hall of Fame. He ran a cricket school in Middlesex between 1924 - 1958 and travelled extensively in this role. Jack died in Ealing in 1965.

Arthur John Dimmock was born in Fenny Stratford in 1888 and enlisted in 1914. He lived at 4 Bedford Cottages, Jacques Lane and was married to Jubilee

Alice Eells. Arthur was a shoeing smith and was posted to France in 1915. He served in France until February 1918. He was demobbed in March 1919 and then lived at The Lodge, Church End, Haynes.

William Dimmock Royal Field Artillery. Little is known of William, other than he served in France from the outbreak of war and was a farrier. He worked for Mr Cakebread who ran the Blacksmiths at what is now the Old Forge by The Green. In 1918 he was severely wounded near Ypres but it is thought that he recovered well.

Harold Doggett was born in Clophill and in 1911 lived in 2, Bedford Cottages, Jacques Lane. He was a Private in the 3rd Sussex Regt. On the 1911 Census, Harold lived with his widowed mother Hannah, 2 older brothers and a younger nephew. His mother had given birth to 16 children, 11 of whom were still alive then. His father, William, a farm labourer had died in 1905. In 1911 Harold was a Domestic Horse Keeper and later he became a market garden labourer. He married Grace Shotbolt in 1927. From at least 1939 until his death in 1962 Harold and his wife, Grace, lived at 16, Bedford Road, Clophill.
