#### Come into the Garden

with Kate Gardner

**October's** crisp autumnal days bring changing colours, shorter days and the occasional frost. If you grow fruit and veg you may still be harvesting and storing this year's crops, but there's plenty more to be getting on with.



If you have a greenhouse, mini greenhouse or cold frame now is the perfect time to sow seeds undercover to give you a whole range of early flowers for next year. Crepis, hollyhocks, sweetpeas, aquilegia and oriental poppies are good choices to try. For something that can take a little longer try sowing Hellebore seeds, but be patient because germination can be a bit slow.

It's not just flowering plants that you can sow now either. 'Winter Gem' lettuce, Mizuna, Mibuna and winter salad leaves can be sown from September to January in an unheated greenhouse or cold frame. Pick the leaves as you need them to add to winter salads. Sow spring onion 'Performer' under cloches and they'll be ready to start harvesting in the spring. Herbs such as basil, dill, chives and parsley can be sown now and grown on your windowsill throughout the winter to give lots of lovely fresh herbs to add to your recipes. If you have an area of the garden where you can direct sow hardy annuals such as cornflowers, poached egg plant, annual poppies and larkspur you will have early flowers to attract bees and butterflies next year. Now is also the perfect time to be planting out daffodil bulbs, tulip bulbs and allium bulbs for a glorious spring display. Dot them through borders or naturalise them in grass.

If you have been growing perennial or biennials such as foxgloves from seed, now is also the best time to plant them out into your borders, along with spring bedding such as wallflowers, bellis, primulas and winter pansies. The garden centres have a fantastic range of plants that can be planted now to give colour and structure right through the autumn and into spring.

Ponds are a lovely addition to any garden and can provide a rich habitat for a range of wildlife. However, without care ponds can soon become an eyesore with overgrown plants, weeds and water that is unhealthy for fish and other wildlife. Occasional cleaning and regular maintenance are required and as we move into autumn it's a good time to place nets over small ponds to prevent autumn leaves falling in.

If you grow tender water plants then remove any dying foliage before you lift the plants and place them in trays of deep mud or damp sand, or even in a bucket of water. Keep them in a frost-free place such as a conservatory or greenhouse, until the risk of frost has passed.

If you didn't get around to tidy up the pond last month, then clear out any debris, weeds and excess oxygenating plants now. Remember to leave the plants on the side of the pond for 24 hours before composting them, so that any wildlife has time to escape back to the pond. Remove pumps or fountains and removable lighting systems, clean them, and store over winter in a safe place.

October is really the last chance to trim deciduous hedges to keep them looking tidy over the winter. Your climbing roses may still have some occasional flowers but now is the time to prune these to ensure a good show for next year. Shrubs normally pruned hard in the spring such as Buddleja davidii, Cornus alba, and Lavatera, should be cut back by half now, to prevent wind rock and to neaten their appearance over the winter months.



## Claphill Preschall News

**Well** what a great start we have had to our 8th year of preschool. We have not stopped after hitting the ground running at the beginning of September. We have had new children booked in to start with us every week since then and continuing past the half term holiday. It is lovely to meet so many families and know that our setting, staff and ethos are what so many people are looking for these days.

It was also lovely to start the term with such glorious weather. Our clothing kit list has become more important than ever as we will be doing all of our play outside from now on. Even when the sun



is shining it is important our children have hats and if they want to explore in the mud pit, they definitely need their wellies and waterproof trousers. As the cold weather approaches, we advise parents on the best clothing and how to layer up. We warn our parents that their children will often get muddy and dirty after a session with us, it is all part of the fun and

learning the freedom of the outdoors offers them.



We released our virtual tour on our Facebook page and our website, on our 7-year anniversary, which felt rather monumental especially in a year when we our intake is up over 80% on previous years. The film allows people to see the staff and some

previous years. The film allows people to see the staff and some of the setting although we have made more developments since we filmed it! The gravel pit has had big road works signs put up in it to set the theme, Spotty and Dotty have had a floor put on their house to stop the foxes getting them, and we have put a new wooden table in our outdoor shelter-come-classroom.

We still have parents wanting to send their children to us and so we are offering visits on Fridays when our Forest School group are usually outside the main setting. It has been interesting talking with parents about the education we can offer through outdoor learning as we show them around; explaining how we teach children everything from social skills and managing their own behaviour, to developing language and listening skills. The simple activity of playing together on the swing helps physical development; building coordination and balance, and it may also involve turn taking. Language is developed as children collaborate, helping each other in and out and take turns; not to mention the use of maths as they consider how hard to push, how long their turn should be, and how many can go in it at once. Every aspect of the outdoors allows children's interests to flourish and our staff to teach as they engage in what they enjoy.

We are holding another clothing collection for Happy Bags on Wednesday 11th November. They collect all usable clothing, handbags, shoes, and accessories. We hope this time to raise enough funds to pay for a wheelchair tray for Ruby who attends our preschool. We would also like to buy some new sit on diggers for the sand and gravel pits. ### Jamie Oliver's Chocolate and Beetroot Cake

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- Olive Oil
- Plain flour, for dusting
- 300g good-quality dark chocolate (70% cocoa solids)
- 250g raw beetroot
- 4 large eggs



- 150g golden castor sugar
- 120g ground almonds
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 tablespoon good-quality cocoa powder
- Natural yoghurt, to serve
- 1. Pre-heat the oven to 180°C, 160° fan, gas mark 4.
- 2. Lightly grease the bottom and sides of a 20cm springform cake tin with olive oil. Use scissors to cut out a circle of greaseproof paper, roughly the same size as the bottom of the tin, and use it to line the base. Dust the sides of the tin lightly with flour, then tap the tin to get rid of any excess.
- **3.** Break 200g of the chocolate into small pieces and add to a heat proof bowl.
- **4.** Place the bowl on top of a small pan of simmering water over a medium heat, making sure the bottom of the bowl isn't touching the water, and allow to melt, stirring occasionally.
- **5.** Once melted, use oven gloves to carefully remove from the heat and put to one side beware of the steam when you lift up the bowl.
- **6.** Use a Y-shaped peeler to peel the beetroot, then cut into chunks on a chopping board.
- **7.** Push the beetroot through the coarse grater attachment on the food processor, then tip into a large mixing bowl.
- **8.** Separate the eggs, placing the whites into a large clean mixing bowl and add the yolks to the beetroot, then wash your hands!!
- **9.** Stir the sugar, almonds, baking powder, cocoa powder and melted chocolate into the beetroot and mix together well.
- **10.** Use an electric hand whisk to whisk the egg whites until you have stiff peaks
- **11.** Use a spatula to fold a quarter of the egg whites into the beetroot mixture to loosen, then once combined, fold in the rest but try not to over mix.
- **12.** Add the mixture to the prepared cake tin and spread out evenly using a spatula.
- **13.** Bake in the hot oven for around 50 minutes, or until risen and cooked through.
- **14.** To check if it's done, stick a cocktail stick or skewer into the middle of the sponge, remove it after 5 seconds and if it comes out clean the cake's cooked; if its slightly sticky it needs a bit longer.
- **15.**Allow the cake to cool slightly, then carefully turn it out onto a wire rack to cool completely.
- **16.**When you're ready to serve, melt the remaining chocolate (in the same way as above), then serve each slice with some yoghurt and a drizzle of the melted chocolate.

### **Community Champions**

Building on Community Champion schemes that have been running as pilots in other areas locally, we are aiming to establish a group of people across our area who are committed to help us to get key messages across to their own networks. Initially about the COVID-19 pandemic, but potentially about other key developments too. It's a simple concept, through which people who are willing to reach out to the people they are in touch with, are provided with public health messaging to help with the control of the pandemic.

You will be supported to do this with regular direct communications about what's happening with the pandemic locally, why particular messaging is key, and relevant materials (infographics, for example) in appropriate formats for you to pass on. It's also a two-way relationship with champions being asked to give us feedback on whether our materials are working in terms of their subject matter and presentation. Regular virtual meetings between Communications and Engagement Team colleagues and Public Health professionals will be held to support ongoing engagement with the champions.

Community leaders and representatives have already been enormously helpful in amplifying many of the public health messages that the Council has been distributing. We hope they will continue to do so and also encourage those people in their own areas who they know are active and well-respected to become champions themselves; in our collective endeavour to control the virus to save lives, support our vulnerable residents and protect livelihoods.

It was another beautiful evening on Tuesday, 15th September, when your Parish Councillors, Ward Councillors and many members of the public Zoomed in for another meeting to discuss matter pertaining to your village.

#### The Chairman made his announcements noting:

- 1. That Clophill Community Care and the Clophill Covid Support group has now amalgamated, acknowledging and thanking the latter for their superb work and help during the past months. The Ward Councillors informed the meeting that there was a CBC 'Covid-19' fund which provided for both revenue and capital expenses, although it was available to individuals rather than via the Parish Council.
- 2. Kate Breed has volunteered to re-join the Parish Council, the Clerk stating that it would be an agenda item at the next meeting, it being too late for this one.
- 3. The Chairman has written to the Enforcement officer at CBC concerning the large domiciliary building which had been placed by the stabling on the Land South of Top Farm (Beadlow). The land has planning permission for stabling but not residential use.
- 4. After some discussion, it was decided that the replacement sign (No Unauthorized Access) on Council Land adjacent to Old Church Path would be an agenda item for the next meeting.

CBC Ward Councillors briefed the meeting on the financial state of CBC, saying that it was in a good position to provide for the potential increase in demands, due to Covid-19 difficulties, having made prudent decisions over preceding years. There was now a Housing Company set up within CBC, its purpose to provide relevant housing which other builders aren't currently providing. The Highways department is identifying maintenance work to ensure greater safety for pedestrians and cyclists where social distancing wasn't easy. This includes hedge trimming on pathways and the refreshing of road markings. ALL MEMBERS of the public can report such issues using the CBC "Report It" facility here: http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/reportit

#### The Clerk presented his report covering:

- 1. The on-going situation at the Green;
- 2. Replacement of the Townshott allotment sign;
- 3. On-going difficulties encountered with the landowner to the repair of the fence at Readshill;
- 4. Lighting supply where the PC has switched provider to save money;
- 5. The replacement of a broken swing seat at the Recreation Ground;
- 6. An anonymous letter from unnamed Clophill residents concerning drug taking was received, but to which no reply could be made as it was anonymous;

- 7. Work on updating the website and lastly;
- 8. A document concerning land adjacent to the Flying Horse, formalising the PCs responsibility for maintenance of the land, which needed to be approved and registered with the Land Registry.

#### Subjects for 'further consideration' covered;

- a) **The Lakes Development** Councillor Walford informed the meeting that the documentation should be completed within a few weeks and Ward Councillors are to chase CBC regarding associated reserved matters;
- b) **Land at the Causeway** where the Chairman set out the situation which was then discussed fully by the Councillors;
- c) **Resuming physical meetings,** it was felt that, due to shielding relatives, the current mode would be continued;
- d) **A scoping application** to build a country village on part of Cainhoe Woods (Beadlow) Golf Club;
- e) A donation to Magpas was approved;
- f) The **Christmas tree and associated power on The Green** was discussed. The Clerk was given powers to purchase appropriate lights for the Norwegian spruce, which was being kindly donated to the village. It was suggested that sponsors could be encouraged to help with the purchases;
- g) **The cost and schedule of works** associated with the upkeep of the cemetery at the Old Church. The Clerk met with relevant people regarding this and has since obtained quotes for ongoing maintenance. It was noted that the staff and volunteers of the EcoLodges had done a phenomenal amount of work to date but they needed more help. They were also owed for their work and the sum is to be paid. A diary of seasonal work is to be investigated and a plan, with costs, produced perhaps for the next meeting;
- h) The trimming before the winter, of the tree on the triangle of land by the Flying Horse car park. Further discussion ensured about furniture on the same piece of land. Namely, an Otter bench has been kindly offered and will be installed soon, also a new picnic bench has been purchased will replace the broken one;
- i) **The Website update** this is nearing completion as noted in the Clerk's report.

Once again, we must thank our Councillors – and the members of the public who sign in - who give of their time and are interested and want to support our village of Clophill. The Councillors are all working folk and yet find time to work on our behalf, giving up many hours of their leisure time to our benefit.

#### Clophill's Serving Survivors of WW1

#### By Sue Pearson

Continuing our series in celebration of Clophill's brave men who fought in and survived the First World war...

#### William Gillett



Born in Walton-le-Dale, Lancashire in 1886. He joined the Navy in 1904. He married assistant teacher, Edith Appleby in Clophill in 1912. After their marriage they lived at Glebe Cottage - now Taylor's Cottage -106 High Street. They had two daughters. In 1914 William was called to serve in the First World War as a Gunner Warrant Officer, re-joining his ship, HMS Mermaid at Dover. During WW1 he also served on HMS Afridi and HMS Forester. He served in the Navy for 44 years, also serving in WWII, gaining the DSO and the rank of Commander. His medals and many of his records are to be seen at the Imperial War Museum in London.



**HMS Forester**- an Acheron class destroyer of which William was second in command in 1918.

In 1923 the family had the "The Moorings" built (also in the High Street) as their family home. He died in 1955.

**George Gobey** was a Private in the Machine Gun Corps (having also served initially with the 4th Beds.). He volunteered in November 1915 and was drafted to France the following year. He served at Albert, the Somme and Ypres. In March 1917 he had a gunshot wound to the shoulder whilst at Bapaume and was admitted to hospital in France. He convalesced in Lytham. He was severely wounded at Cambrai in November 1917 and was sent back to England for treatment. He subsequently returned to the Western Front and he was seriously wounded and gassed in March 1918. He was demobilised the following year and he received the General Service and Victory Medals. He lived in High Street, Clophill.

He was born in Clophill on 29th August 1896 and in 1911, George was a 14 year old Labourer to a Market Gardener. He was living in the 118 High Street with his father, Joel, a Labourer/Woodman, his mother Sarah and 6 siblings. An elder sister was no longer living at home. The family were called Gobby on the 1901 census. George died in December 1978, aged 82.

Harry Gobey was a Private in the Bedfordshire, then East Lancashire and then the 2/1st Suffolk Yeomanry and in 1911 lived in the Slade with his parents John and Mary and 4 of his siblings. His parents had 9 children. His father was a farm labourer as was Harry. He was born in 1896 in Clophill. In July 1916, Ampthill News reported that Harry had been wounded in the head and was now recovering in a hospital in Scotland. It said it was the second time he had been wounded. In September 1916 the paper reported that he had returned to France and had been on the Frontline since the start of the war and was "an expert bomber." He was awarded the Star. Harry continued to live with his parents in the Slade until at least 1928.
